### A Guide to completing your USA Hockey Officiating Registration

#### Steps to Becoming a Level 1 Official

1. Must complete online registration at <https://membership.usahockey.com/>
2. Must submit Registration Fee (\$45.00 + applicable Affiliate Fee)
3. Must attain an **Open Book Exam** score of 35/50 (or higher)
4. Must attend and complete a Level 1 Officials Seminar sanctioned by USA Hockey.

5. Must complete **SafeSport** training (if 2005 Birth Year, or older)  
Register at <https://www.usahockey.com/safesporttraining>
6. Must complete and maintain a USA Hockey sanctioned criminal **Background Screen** if 18(+) years old on June 1, 2022.  
Register at <https://www.usahockey.com/backgroundscreen>
7. If 14+ and PA Resident: Complete PA Act 15 Screenings  
Register at <https://www.aahaofficials.com/pa-act-15>

#### Accessing Online Modules

Each year as part of the USA Hockey Officiating Education Program officials are required to complete the online module training.

1. To access the online modules go to: <https://courses.usahockey.com/public>
2. Sign in to your profile
3. Click on the link for **Officials Online Seminar Modules**
4. When the new page loads, click on **Officiating Courses** then click **Online Seminar Modules**
5. Click on the available course.
6. Click the enroll button to start the modules.

You are required to complete all of the **Required Modules** and a specific number of **Elective Modules**.

2. Set your availability (when you are able to work games) and your rink preferences (where you are willing to work). It is important to keep this information up to date.
3. Contact your local assignor by email or phone (**THIS MUST BE DONE BY THE OFFICIAL NOT A PARENT**)
