- 2. Expenses paid: \$81,351.02 in expenses in December 2018
- 3. Estimated expenses upcoming: Anticipate expenses of \$100,000 in January 2019
- 4. Income received (prior month): \$66,317.83 in revenues in December 2018
- 5. Estimated income upcoming: Anticipate revenues of \$70,000 in January 2019

We have fronted money for the Wild Mite Day/Men's & Women's Gopher Games. We still have quite a few ice bills for the month of October/November/December that need to be paid. We will be sending out an email to the association and team managers about this. January Ice Bills will be getting sent out mid-January. We are tracking on budget for the year.

Centra Sota Community Lawn Care sent in a check for \$2,235.19 for their Summer Weed Control and Fertilizer Program. When you order your weed control and fertilizer through Community Lawn Care, a portion of the sales are credit to the BYHA each year.
