

OTHS BOOSTER CLUB MEETING
October 13, 2021

There was no correspondence. Tiffany presented the treasurer's reports through September on behalf of Bill Vogel. The ending balance through 9/30/21 is \$87,833.85. The reports were approved by Ginny Phillips and seconded by Sam Haage. ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

FOOTBALL 50/50 (Debbie Meyer) Debbie reported total profit to date of \$1490 (3 home football games and Red & White Night).

FOOTBALL CONCESSIONS (Dawn Wilson) Mike Cooper reported approximately \$14,000 in sales through 3 home games. Booster Club splits profits from concession stand sales with the football program. A deposit for these sales has not yet been made and therefore is not included in the bank account balance mentioned above.
