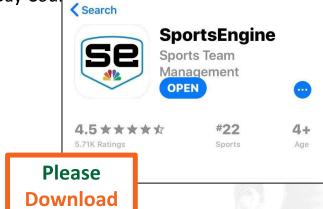
Home Game Support

Important Information

- PARENTS MUST BE IMMEDIATELY AVAILABLE during practice in the event of inclement weather or injury.
- COACHES & PLAYERS ONLY allowed on practice field
- HYDRATE! Players must bring water for practices.
- NO CLIMBING on/over fences
- Please do not leave trash behind and don't forget your child's water bottle.

Inclement Weather Policy

- Lightning Strike <10 miles: EVERYONE must evacuate the practice field, suspend practice 30 min.
- **Practice Cancellations:** LHS Board monitors inclement weather to make decisions by 5:30 PM.
- Cancelled Practices may be made up on Fridays at Board or Head Coach's discretion
- ALL Notifications are sent via Sports Engine App

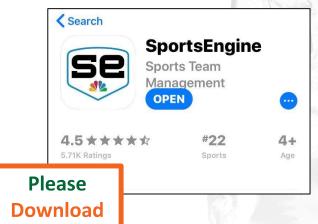
Pregame

- Beginning the day prior, <u>Hydrate! Hydrate!</u>
- Player MUST be fully-dressed by the designated arrival time (full pads/uniform/helmet/etc.)
- The hour prior to kickoff includes warmups, weigh ins, and gametime decisions/changes... no time to waste!
- Players that miss weigh-in are ineligible to play until 2nd half
- Gameday Updates are sent via Sports Engine App
- This time is for coaches and players to make adjustments, rest, and hydrate.
- ONLY coaches, players, and authorized staff allowed on the field!

Required Gametime Equipment (missing items may prevent play)

- Helmet
- Shoulder Pads
- Uniform Pants + Jersey
- Cleats
- Mouthpiece (teeth guard)

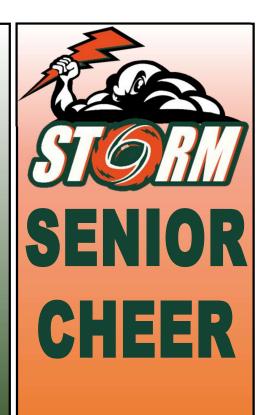

Game Day Cheer

- 1. SHOWTIME: 60 minutes prior to start time at cheer tent
 - Hydrated, rested, and prepared (use your bow-to-toe checklist; take your cheerleader to the bathroom prior to arriving to the tent)
- 2. WARM UPS: 30 minutes prior to start time
- 3. Cool Down: 20 minutes prior to start time (hydrate, stretch)
- 4. Line up: 10 minutes prior to start time
- 5. Half Time: Halftime show for home games, then snack. Cheerleaders <u>may</u> <u>not</u> leave the cheer tent during halftime.
- 6. Collect: all gear before leaving the field. Parents may pick up at cheer tent following the game. Cell Phones will remain in backpacks for the entirety of the game.
