

# HOW TO REGISTER: LEARN TO SKATE PROGRAM AND ADVANCED PROGRAM

Step-by-step process for registering your skater(s) for participation in our Learn to Skate Program AND our Advanced Program

## STEP ONE

### Determine the Membership Level Your Skater Must Have

- If your skater may test via U.S. Figure Skating (pre-preliminary and above) and/or competing at a non-qualifying/qualifying level (Juvenile and above), skater will need a Full USFS Membership. **If this applies to your skater, SKIP STEP 2.**
- If skater is not testing and/or competing at a non-qualifying/qualifying level (i.e. Basic 2, Aspire 3, Excel Freeskate), skater will need a Learn to Skate USA Membership.

*\*No skater needs both memberships\**

## STEP TWO

### Complete Learn to Skate Membership

Complete annual 'Learn to Skate USA' Membership at [www.learntoskateusa.com](http://www.learntoskateusa.com) > click 'login/renew' and follow the prompts on the screen.

**Save your invoice number, this is needed to complete your registration with LRFSC**

## STEP THREE

### Determine Your Level of Enrollment for the Learn to Skate Program

"LTS Individual" OR "LTS Family"

For one skater only, choose "LTS Individual".  
For families with two or more skaters, choose "LTS Family".

Both levels grant access to two parent/guardians to skate on 'Family Ice'.

*\*If siblings of the same household want to skate on Family Ice, you must select LTS Family regardless.*

## STEP FOUR

### Complete Registration with LRFSC

Complete annual registration with LRFSC at [www.lrskating.com/reg](http://www.lrskating.com/reg) > follow the prompts on the screen.

As your skater is participating in BOTH the Learn to Skate Program AND the Advanced Program, begin your registration as if you are registering for the Learn to Skate Program. As you proceed through the registration, there will be an **option to ADD ON the Advanced Program**, select this.

*\*In doing so, an automatic discount will be applied to your total cost of registration (excluding membership).*

Remember, if your skater needs a Full USFS Membership, select this option within the registration (it will be added to your total due and the club will renew this membership on your behalf).

## STEP FIVE

### Complete Advanced Athlete Intake Form

Complete this form at [www.lrskating.com/advancedprogram](http://www.lrskating.com/advancedprogram) to share your scheduling preferences & athlete goals. This is needed for our coaching team to set our schedule and plan the season!

**Due by Friday, October 3<sup>rd</sup>**

## STEP SIX

### Watch Email for Advanced Program Lesson Schedule & Information

The official schedule will be posted no later than Monday, October 13<sup>th</sup>. A mandatory pre-season meeting must be attended by the athlete and one parent/guardian to complete additional paperwork.
