



COVID-19 Return to Play Guidelines

HOCKEY

- Follow all local and state guidelines for facilities and events.
- Each team is required to take the temperature of each player and coach before practice/game begins. LCAHA will supply each team with a thermometer and a chart to track temperatures. Any player or coach with a temperature of 100.4 will be removed until the next scheduled event.
- Each team must provide a locker room monitor to unlock the locker room prior to use and lock afterwards.
- The Teams will enter in a designated door and exist thru a different designated door.
- No parents will be permitted into the locker rooms.
- Parents will be permitted in the rink area and must practice social distancing.
- Allow players to wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) items if they choose, if the items do not compromise the safety of any and all participants in the game.
- Require teams to clean their locker room of all trash and other items after each use.
- The Twp. staff will clean and disinfect each locker room prior to each use.
- Spitting of any kind is strictly prohibited.
- Parents are permitted to be at practice, however, must maintain social distancing practices.
- There will be no sharing of equipment, water bottles or any item necessary to play the game.
- Coaches will be supplied with disinfectant and hand sanitizer.
- Facial coverings are recommended but not required.
- Players and coaches will not shake hands after games. They will line up on the blue lines and applaud each other for good sportsmanship.
- Players must bring their individual water bottles with their name and/or jersey number on the bottle. LCAHA will provide one water bottle per player. Players must fill their own bottles.
