

## **MBA 8U League Rules**

## Ground Rules

- 1. All players on the roster will bat each half inning
- 2. When 3 outs are recorded during a half inning all bases will be cleared and number of outs starts at zero.
- 3. Batters and runners must wear helmets and should wear caps beneath to avoid rashes, lice, etc.
- 4. No metal cleats are allowed.
- 5. Catchers must wear a helmet and be far enough away from the batter.
- 6. Base runners must not lead off. There is no stealing allowed.
- 7. Try to have players avoid head first slides.
- 8. Each batter will be allowed 5 swings. The coaches will pitch (from a knee is best). There will be no walks. Batters are not awarded first base if they are hit. Pitches can be underhand and from a closer distance after the first 5 pitches.
- 9. No extra bases may be taken on any overthrows, including first base.
- 10. Baserunners cannot advance on a ball hit to the outfield once the ball has reached the infield/pitcher.
- 11. There will be no bunting.
- 12. The last batter can only advance bases based on the rules, they will not "circle" the bases because they are the last hitter.
- 13. Coaches will do umpiring.

## **Rotations/Playing Time**

- 1. All players on roster will bat during each half inning in the same place in the order.
- 2. All players on the roster will play in the field each inning. Each team will field as normal of a line up as possible. If short players, have a coach be catcher, or don't have a player stand by the pitcher. Each player will get equal opportunity to play different positions. Only exception is 1st base. Don't put a player there who could get injured because they can't catch.

## Games and Practices

- 1. Please follow the game and practice schedule times.
- 2. Do not start a new inning if both teams won't be able to bat, based on time.
- 3. Please follow coaching development ideas, use our language as much as possible, have a practice plan ready.
- 4. Focus should be development and fun, not winning.
- 5. Coaches are in charge of communicating with parents about cancellations.
- 6. Coordinators will contact coaches about cancellations.
- 7. Coaches should hand in all picture items, schedules, and fundraising information at first practice.
- 8. Equipment turn in will be on family night.
