Reports:

Presidents: Mindy

She asked about our DHS Wish List and Cliff commented that it's hard to plan ahead not knowing what the renovations will disrupt so he is concentrating on things like new weight room equipment that can easily be moved during the renovations. Cliff is considering doing a NLI signing day in December but nothing has been decided. It may be easier to do one Signing day in the spring when more students will have committed. Mindy is planning the Scholarship Committee and needs thoughts on the requirements. Currently students who apply must have a 3.5 GPA and have played a sport all 4 years of high school. Mindy volunteered to Chair the Scholarship committee since she doesn't have any conflicts of interest. She will work on getting members to join the committee and report back at the next meeting. Mindy also reported that the concessions stand ice machine is not working. Cliff will add repairs to the current work order. Mindy received an e-mail from Jeff Sullivan regarding a meeting of current BC Presidents at Northwest High School on Nov. 30 at 6pm. Mindy would like to get fundraising ideas at the meeting. She asked anyone with ideas for discussion at the meeting to reach out to her. Mindy would like to start recruiting for next year and reported that she is looking for someone to shadow her next year who would eventually takeover as President. Next school year will be her last school year as President. The netting around the parking lot needs to be replaced and Mindy will look into the cost for that.

Old Business:

The Ella Strong vigil raised \$1,480.00. Kellie suggested that BC donate a total of \$1500.00 to charity. Mindy made a motion and it was unanimously approved. Leander reported that the Family Photo session fundraiser went well. The photographer Mike Clark even did free senior photos to any family with a senior. Mike agreed to do the fundraiser again next year. Approximately \$1,000 was raised. Leander would like to do the fundraiser again next year and set a date soon so advertising can start earlier. Ashly reported that the Powder Puff game was a success.

There were no injuries and everyone participating signed a waiver. Concessions raised approximately \$320 and the entrance fees raised were \$1600.

Treasurer: Kellie

The Treasurer's Report is attached and was passed out at the meeting. It includes a general, profit, and budget report. Kellie noted that boys' basketball should consider fundraising. She reported that taking credit card payments has been successful. To date concessions has raised \$13,655.00 and \$9,790.00 has been raised selling merchandise.

Lisa reported that merchandise supplies are running low. She plans on selling merchandise at a basketball game and will try to sell a Swarm t shirt at a basketball game. She plans to ask on social media if we should hold a Holiday Sale and decide based on the response. The online store will open for 2 weeks and then close to process orders and reopen on a continuing 2 week cycle. Lisa will look into Swarm towels to be given away to students to wave at games. Lisa hopes to sell 200 long sleeved gray Swarm shirts for the first football playoff game. She plans to sell any leftover Swarm shirts if there is a second playoff game November 18.

We currently have 110 members. Kellie will verify that we have received all member fees from anyone who joined with the PTSA.

Concessions: Danielle

Concessions will soon transition from outside to inside as the fall season is winding down. Concessions plans to open for basketball and wrestling this winter.
