Reports:

Merchandise: Robyn

The Baseball team has purchased a small tractor to grade the baseball and softball fields for \$6500 and are asking for assistance in paying for it.

After some discussion it was determined that we need to ask coaches where the money came from to purchase this since it has not been recorded with the Treasurer and submitted.

It was also noted that in the future it would be helpful to have a breakdown of our members and which teams they support so reimbursements can be more fairly decided. It was also noted that many teams are not asking for money while other teams ask regularly for reimbursements so it would also be helpful to spread the word to all teams to ask for reimbursement on necessary team items.

Due to the above reasons the decision was made to table the vote for a %25 of the \$6500 to be reimbursed and to allow time to verify whether or not softball will be helping to pay for the tractor.

Tony will look into working with more with the PTSA to communicate activities and events.

Mindy will look into the cost of purchasing a back drop for a possible College Signing event in mid- April to May.

Everything is on schedule for the Booster Club scholarship.

We are in need of a Concessions Coordinator and Namita Thapar- Dua has offered to help. The goal would be to have one person in charge of food and another be in charge of volunteers.

Carrie Butler has agreed to be the Chair of the Nominating Committee.
