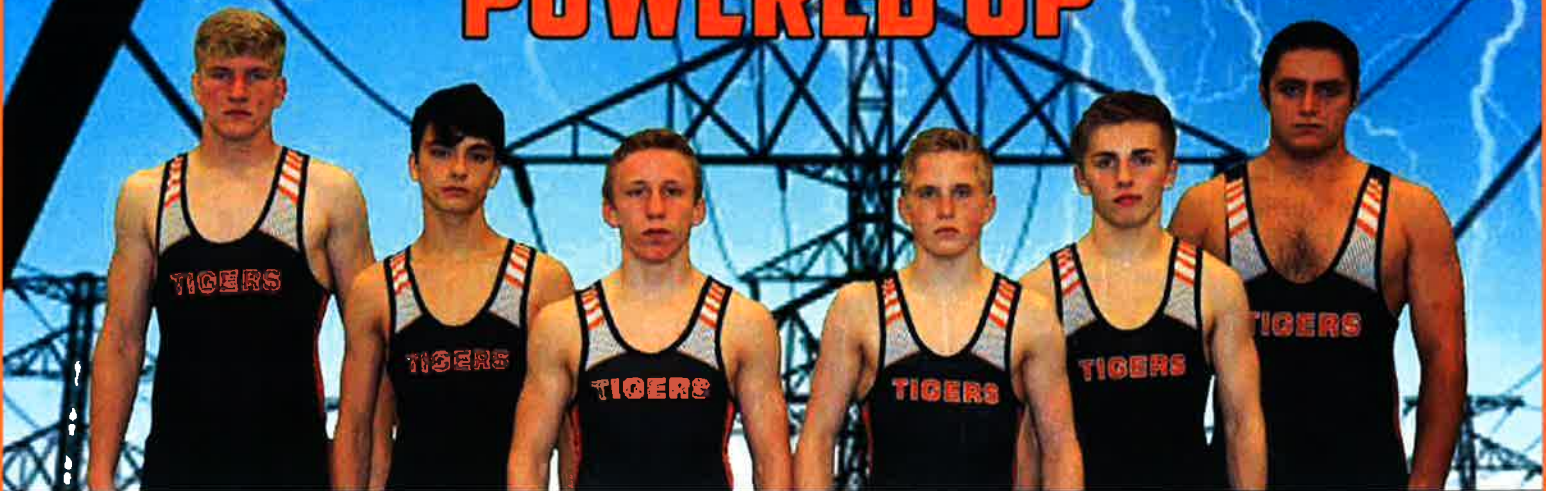

## 2016-2017 Junior Varsity Season Overview

The junior varsity team did an outstanding job this season. It was a pleasure coaching this group of young men as they always came to practice ready to work hard and get better. Each of these young men and their guardians should be extremely proud of their efforts and accomplishments this season. As their coach I am proud of what they were able to achieve individually and as a team on and off the mat.

This year's team had an undefeated dual meet record of 23-0. They were once again Southwestern Conference Champions (SWC). The team competed in three other tournaments this season: Mehlville JV Duals (1<sup>st</sup> Place/16 Teams), Mt. Olive Varsity Tournament (2<sup>nd</sup> Place/15 Teams) and Lincoln JV Tournament (1<sup>st</sup> Place/18 Teams).

After starting the season 6-0 in duals at our annual JV Super Duals the team traveled to Mehlville High School to participate in their holiday tournament. This is always a fun time of the season to see where we were at with some of top programs in Missouri. As usual we competed extremely hard going 5-0 in duals to capture the team title for the sixth straight year.

The team competed in the Lincoln JV tournament again this season showing the teams from central Illinois what the south is all about. Our kids came ready to go and wrestled extremely tough and came away with many good individual accomplishments. There were no team points taken in this one but Coach Followell assured me that if there were we would have won it.

We decided as a staff to challenge the boys once again this season by entering them into the Mt. Olive Varsity Tournament for the second year in a row. I was extremely proud of the way the team competed in the tournament and how they earned the respect of many other varsity programs. The team took 2<sup>nd</sup> place overall without filling one of the weight classes making me feel very good about the depth of our team and the direction the program is going.

The JV team capped off a perfect dual meet season going 6-0 at the SWC JV Dual Tournament. The teams dominated each of their respected pools by each going 3-0 with wins over Alton, Belleville East, Belleville West, O'Fallon, Granite City and Collinsville. The team had more individual champions, runner-ups and third place finishers than any other team in the conference.

I would like to thank the parents of all the wrestlers for supporting their sons this season. Without your support it would be very difficult to be the program we are today. I appreciate the time you allow us to spend with your sons and allowing us to help you mold them into great young men of character on and off the mat.

I would also like to thank the senior wrestlers/parents and managers for their hard work, dedication and passion you have shown for the program over the years. 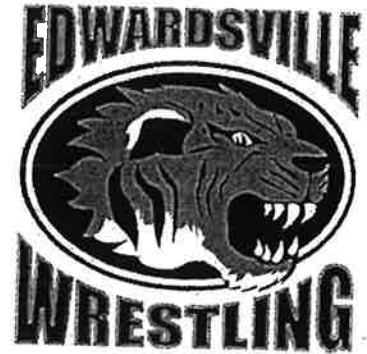
