**Fee: \$300-** Varsity and JV are included - Friday's 9<sup>th</sup> grade team is a separate fee (\$75)

**Entrance-** Teams should enter the Fieldhouse entrance (door 3) of the building. **Buses should be parked at your hotel or in the Football/Track Complex lot.** Redwood Valley School is in session on Friday, buses and school vehicles may not park on the road in front of the building. Doors will open to the Link area at 12 pm on Friday and 6:30 am on Saturday.

**Locker Rooms:** There will be three locker rooms available for athletes to dress and shower on the south end of the gym and two locker rooms alongside the field house. There are no assigned team locker rooms. **Please inform your athletes to treat the facilities with respect.**

1. Names of all athletes on your team is due by **Wednesday Nov. 29th**. (This is for t-shirts, which will have names on them, so please get this in)

2. **Varsity and JV Rosters will be done online using Track Wrestling (Tony Wolfbauer will be sending you information) Deadline to enter Roster is Wednesday Dec. 13<sup>th</sup> at 6pm.** Seeding will be done using Track wrestling. Only 1 wrestler per team may enter a weight class in the Varsity division.

JV/ Middle School(only for those under 100lbs we are calling it MS, still grades 7 and up) is unlimited Entries. Wrestlers must weigh in and qualify for a weight class. We will be making 4 man or 6 man brackets whenever possible set up by age as best as we can.

3. **IMPORTANT: IF YOUR WRESTLER DOES NOT MAKE WEIGHT, HE/SHE WILL BE SCRATCHED FROM THE TOURNAMENT. Varsity Division only.**

4. Registration/packet pick-up will be in the Links area of the Redwood Valley Field house from **12pm-1:30pm** on Friday, Dec. 15<sup>th</sup>. Mats will be open for workouts from **12pm-tourney start**.

5. **Team camps will be in our commons area, which is just past the wrestling/coaches room, we will have supervision in this area. No one is to be upstairs.** Keep it clean to avoid a cleaning charge.

**Weigh-ins and Skin Checks: Friday December 15<sup>th</sup> at 2:00pm (there is 1 lb weight allowance given per NFHS Rules, i.e. 107 has to be on or under 108.0).**

**Weigh-ins: Saturday December 16<sup>th</sup> at 7AM. JV Will weigh-in immediately following Varsity Weigh-ins.** (there is a 2 pound weight allowance, i.e. 107 has to be on or under 109.0). Doors will open at 6:30am.

8. Coaches Meeting: **Friday, Dec 15<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 PM—Seeding will be done by a committee on Wednesday Dec. 14<sup>th</sup> and will be release to coaches- any questions should be emailed so that we can discuss at the meeting.**

9. Wrestling Begins: **December 15<sup>th</sup> at 4PM**—A tentative event schedule is attached with this letter.

10. Finals: Saturday **December 16<sup>th</sup> starting approximately at 5PM. Finals will run continuously until done. Awards will be done in hallway and shown on video board.**

11. Concessions- There will be a full concessions provided by the Redwood Area Wrestling Association at the South End of the Field House. Wrestlers can use the concessions area after weigh-ins to eat. **If your team is looking to have a team breakfast onsite, you must get prior approval.**

12. The hospitality room- will be provided and sponsored by the Redwood Area Wrestling Association located in the Wrestling room. Please clean up after yourselves.

14. Awards- Tournament Champions will receive a medal and a t-shirt, Medals for 2<sup>nd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>. Team Champions, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> will receive a trophy. There will be an outstanding wrestler and Pin award on the Varsity (most pins/least amount of time Champ side only).

15. Bus Parking- Please have Buses Park off site or in our Football/ Track complex parking. Around Walmart. Door to the Redwood Community Center will be open for drivers to enter.

16. **Video Streaming will be available through FloWrestling(Track Wrestling).**
