The Northwest Diamond Series expects fans, along with athletes and coaches, to uphold the values of sportsmanship, respect, and civility at all Northwest Diamond Series events and locations. While there isn't one single, universally applied "conduct policy statement," the Northwest Diamond Series expects all participants to conduct themselves in a manner befitting the game of baseball. In essence, our policy advocates for:

- Respectful and positive behavior: Encouraging fans, coaches and players to support their teams positively while refraining from rude, vulgar, or intimidating language or actions.
- Civility and courtesy: Treating opposing teams, coaches, fans, and officials with respect.
- Discouraging disruptive behavior: Prohibiting actions like throwing objects, interfering with the competition, or entering the field of play.
- Creating a safe and inclusive environment: Fostering an atmosphere free from discrimination and harassment based on factors like race, gender, religion, or sexual orientation.

Overall, the underlying goal is to ensure a positive, competitive, and respectful experience for everyone involved in the Northwest Diamond Series. Should any team, coach, player or fan conduct themselves in a manner which does not reflect our policies, the Northwest Diamond Series has the right to remove them from an event, potentially impacting their participation in future events.
