The MN Boys HS Volleyball Association has received a number of questions surrounding COVID-19 "Coronavirus".

We will continue to follow the direction from the administration from our individual schools. We encourage you to follow any district communication concerning COVID-19. They have been communicating how to take precautionary measures to ensure everyone in our school environments are following proper hygiene standards. 95% of our Schools are playing and practicing in school facilities so each school team will need to follow their school administrators directions.

Based on how this situation progresses, we will communicate the status as we get closer to the start of the season. This is the general approach that we will take for now.

- We will encourage our schools make decisions based on their own districts administrative direction.
- We trust that all of our school districts have the best interests of our students in mind. MN Schools are closely following the recommendations from the MN Dept of Health and other local health officials. We will follow and respect whatever protocol and decisions your schools make pertaining to activities and sports.
- To follow suit with many other MN metro JVA and NCR club volleyball events being cancelled this weekend, The Scrimmage this Saturday at Anoka Ramsey is cancelled until further notice. A cancellation email went out to those 9 participating schools earlier today.

We would leave it up to you as the director/coach of your club to make the daily practice decisions you deem necessary to keep everyone healthy.

As news continues to emerge regarding the novel coronavirus, we want to remind student athletes and staff that washing your hands, covering your mouth when coughing or sneezing, and remaining at home when sick or feverish are the best ways to prevent the spread of flu or other respiratory illnesses.
