AWARDS: Kim D. presented club awards to the following recipients who received a certificate of appreciation and \$50 gift card. The selection committee was comprised of last year's winners.

- **Distinguished Service Award** went to Lynda Clark for being the best president and whose service goes above and beyond volunteering.
- **Spirit Award-** Steve Carlson typifies the “spirit of the club” and has given time and effort to improve activities and trips for club members. He is doing a great job in social media, encouraged folks to check out BBSC on Facebook.
- **Sally Rutledge Inspirational Award-** went to Chris Barnes who has the courage and tenacity to overcome challenges and completed the Sellaronda in Italy. This is no easy feat; it took Lynda and Chris all day to complete the tour.
- **Volunteer of the Year Drawing conducted by Fred Uranga-** went to Lynda Clark, who has served over six years as president for BBSC. Lynda won five individual day passes for Bogus Basin.

Special Guest Andy Mork presented highlights of 2025 season at Bogus Basin highlighted below. Andy assists Bogus Basin Board with their permit process of Pine Creek.

- At the end of 2025 season, Bogus was 2.4 million ahead of budget, that’s 1.2 million over previous year.
- Conditions fabulous overall- received almost 300 inches of snow, 120% of normal, had over 500,000 skier days. Set new records, has drone that counts cars, 5,100 cars exceed space availability.

- 2025 plans with fuels management objective and wildfire mitigation to include treatments of selective logging to decrease fire risk and mitigate diseased trees.
- Talked about proposed road closures from 8-11am and 1-3pm and will reopen June 20, 2025.
- Pioneer Lodge upgrades, night skiing for Bitterroot area, purchased more snow guns for backside, old showcase lift will off ramp at top of Tiger run.
