President Report

Royal Rumble Tournament Director

- Positives
 - Hopkins Nutrition and volunteers did a great job
 - Smaller tourney made board coverage easier, set up and tear down easier, less incidents overall
 - EMT crew was great
 - RAC was a great site
 - Liked only using 2 courts in the North Activity Structure (less hot, loud)
- Scheduling: Discussion about both positive and negatives of scheduling two games Saturday and one game Sunday. Game structure possibly contributed to lower concessions revenue since families weren't at the gym for long periods of time. Three games on one day (scheduled close together) is popular with families. Sat/Sun game split can save player energy.
- Some discussion on pros and cons of keeping tourney on MLK weekend or moving it. Group decided to keep the tourney on MLK weekend and work with associations early to establish reciprocity. Jeff will schedule all possible Hopkins sites now to hold dates.
- Opportunities:
 - Lost revenue due to less teams registered
 - Look into budget for new banners/step & repeat
 - Research a new ref crew next year - some issues with the crew chief
 - Look into tables/chairs in hallways to increase seating for concessions and possibly setting up concessions in the cafeteria
 - Relook at the maps and naming conventions (e.g., RAC vs HHS) and signage for HHS court and RAC courts
 - Sites: Consider not using North Activity Structure, consider using West on Saturday night and Sunday, Dan to contact Breck, possibly look into Minnetonka HS, consider using Tanglen as a championship court experience (music, announcements, banners, etc.)
