

Princeton Youth Hockey Association

- A. USA Hockey/ Minnesota Hockey Rules apply.
- B. Medical Personnel
 - A Certified Athletic Trainer, Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), paramedic or medical or osteopathic physician shall be in attendance at all games. This group shall include a licensed health care professional (such as a Registered Nurse) or other person who has successfully completed and maintained certification for programs conducted by the Red Cross or the American Heart Association for all of the following:
 - 1. Advanced First Aid
 - 2. Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
 - 3. Basic Life Support
 - 4. Qualified First Responder
- C. Referees: USA Hockey registered referees will be used. Referee and Jamboree Officials decisions are final.
- D. Release of Liability
 - The tournament, its officials, arena facilities, and all personnel connected with the tournament shall not be held liable or responsible for any injuries, losses, or damages that may be suffered by a player, coach, manager, or spectator during the tournament. Participation in the tournament will constitute acceptance of these terms.
- E. Penalties
 - Penalties will be assessed according to the USA Hockey rulebook. Penalties are run time. Peewees 1.5 minutes, Bantams 2 minutes.
- F. Each team will play 4 games.
- G. Peewee games will consist of three 15 minute run time periods. Stop time for the last 5 minutes of the 3rd period, unless there is a 5 or more goal differential during the third period. Game will run to its conclusion. Bantam games will consist of three 17 minute run time periods. Stop time for the last 5 minutes of the 3rd period, unless there is a 5 or more goal differential during the third period. Game will run to its conclusion.
- H. Each team will have one timeout per game.
- I. Should the game end with the score tied, the game ends in tie.
- J. There is a four minute warm-up.

- K. There is a 1 minute rest period between periods.
- L. Resurface before each Pee wee and Bantam game.
- M. Minimum of 2 hours between games for each team.
- N. Head coach or manager must provide a roster and fill out Game sheet roster.
- O. One person from each team will be responsible for working the penalty box.
- P. Team listed first on the lobby screen will wear light jerseys and the second team listed will wear dark jerseys.
- Q. Twenty skaters total (including goalies) may be rostered and suited up per team, for each game. All players on the bench, including players not dressed to play in the game, must wear a helmet, facemask, and team jersey.
- R. All visitors must comply with the Princeton Ice Arena policies.
