Club Program

- Eligibility requirement one of the first two statements meets requirement:
 - Students who are currently enrolled and attending the Pewaukee School District are eligible to participate in the club program.
 - O Club roster may include up to 20% of a roster with a student attending a private/parochial school in the area as long as the family's residential address resides within the boundary lines of the Pewaukee School District.
 - Private School family signs a letter of intention their child will attend Pewaukee School District starting in 9th grade.
- Great competition, fundamentally driven and good learning experience for kids.
- Goal is to improve individual skills of each player and strengthen basketball program in Pewaukee.
 - o Building strong fundamentals; instilling a competitive drive with a mental toughness and commitment is required.
 - Provide balance between being competitive, and providing playing opportunities. Opportunities provided does not mean equal playing time.
 - Success is measured by improvement of individual player, and overall improvement of the team. Success is not measured by wins and losses although there is a desire to win!

Participation Levels

- Two teams per grade depending on number of participants trying out and skill level.
 - o Both tryout numbers and skill (talent) level are factors in determining number of teams.
 - o Maximum number of players per roster will be (10) players per team; Minimum of (7-8) players per team.
 - New Students in the fall will be provided opportunity to tryout; team rosters may be adjusted accordingly.
- Two teams in the same grade, may practice together, although they will play separate league and tournament schedule.
- Players may move from roster-to-roster as necessary. Determined by Program Director.

Tryout Information and Process

- Information
 - o Register child or children on website for tryouts.
 - o Tryout Times are published on the website at www.pewaukeebasketball.com
 - o Parents **are not invited** to attend the tryout sessions.
- Process
 - o Player's basketball skills as well as their attitude, hustle, effort and listening skills are also evaluated.
 - We expect all returning players to be able to use both hands especially after 5th grade.
 - o Tryouts determine selection of players for the team. Determined by selection committee.
 - o Spring evaluation date with call back list.
 - Coach's evaluation prepared by coaching staffs to share with selection committee only.
 - o Fall-tryout day to determine final rosters for each grade; Final tryout date will be in mid to late August

• Post Tryouts

- o Parents please do not contact us until 4-weeks after teams are announced to inquire about tryout results and team selections.
- o Understandably you may have questions although we are busy preparing for the season during this time.

Club Season - Practices and Games

- Practice Schedule
 - o Determined before prior month at a monthly coaches meeting.
 - o Practices begin as soon as possible in October, possibly the end of September.
 - o Coach will contact your family regarding the first practice.
 - We work around Fall Sports & Activities as much as possible.
- League Schedule
 - Leagues begin for girls and boys in early November; league games are played on Saturday's or Sunday's.

- 4th Grade Teams
 - o Practice (1-2) practices per week depending on gym space
 - o Play approximately (30-35) games for the season
 - o Play (4) weekend tournaments (including Pewaukee Tournament)
- 5th-6th Grade Teams
 - o Practice (2-3) times per week depending on league/tournament schedule
 - o Play (35-40) games in a season including league and/or weekend tournaments
 - o Play in (5) weekend tournaments (including Pewaukee Tournament)
- 7th-8th Grade Teams
 - o Practice (2-3) times per week depending on league/tournament schedule
 - o Play (40-45) games in a season including league and/or weekend tournaments
 - o Play (6) weekend tournaments (including Pewaukee Tournament)
- · Weekend tournaments will be determined and announced by the coach in advance
- Each team may travel to overnight tournaments; overnight tournaments may vary depending on team

Fees and Expenses

- Participation Base Fee is \$575
 - o Fee is Non-Refundable for quitting or being dismissed from the team.
 - Practice jersey is included with base fee; Team socks will no longer be ordered.
 - o All players are required to wear socks and shoes matching uniforms.
 - White, Black, Red and Gray colors are permitted.
 - No fashionable socks to make an individual statement.
- Required Uniform pieces will be available Ala Carte (subject to change based on any price increases)
 - O Game Jersey (\$60), Game Short (\$55), Shooting Shirt (\$45), Back Pack (\$75)
 - Barring no significant cost increases from last fall.
 - First year players are required to purchase each item; Returning players purchase what is needed.
 - Back packs should be used for Pewaukee Basketball Club activities only!
- Training & Player Skill Development sessions are included in fees.
 - o Holidays and In-Service School days are used for skill session training days.

Club Registration

- Uniform Sizing held at PHS Cafeteria everyone must attend!
 - Registration goes live after Uniform Sizing is completed in the fall.
 - Registering for the <u>CLUB PROGRAM</u> occurs after you complete Uniform Sizing.
 - Registration needs to be completed on time in order to order uniforms on time.
- Player Registration, Code of Conduct, Concussion, and Medical Information/Release forms will all be
 electronically filled out and signed during the registration process on the website.
- Payment is done through the registration process. Credit Card or Bank Routing process is available during the registration process. All payments are handled online!
 - We are unable to refund uniform costs, these are fixed costs we cannot refund. There are no program refunds if you
 opt out after registration or quit during the season. We budget teams and costs on your participation.

Parental Expectations & Responsibilities

- Please be on-time dropping off and picking-up child from practices and games.
- Work the clock and scorebook at league & tournament games.
 - Each parent will be scheduled to work 4-5 hours at Pewaukee tournaments we host.
- Contact your coach, in advance, when your child is unable to make a practice or game.
- Parents are expected to be supportive of the entire team, players and coaches!
 - o 48-Hour Rule parents may not contact a coach until 48-Hours following a practice or game.
 - Please **do not** discuss any player or specific team situation with a coach after/during a game.
 - Work through coaches before contacting board members of the club.
- Please be Respectful, Rational and Responsible representing the Pewaukee Basketball Club

Player Expectations & Responsibilities

- Player must be at practices and need to be on time for all practices and games.
 - Work hard to improve your skills and dedicate yourself to your team & individual role; be a good teammate!
- Represent Pewaukee, Basketball Club and yourself in an appropriate manner.
 - Representing the name on the front of your jersey not the name on the back of your jersey!
- Players <u>are responsible</u> for grades and homework assignments.
 - Poor classroom performance and behavior can prevent you from being in the game.
- Please consider it a privilege to participate on club team. Players are not guaranteed any special entitlement.
 - o Be humble regarding the opportunity to play for a club team & hungry to develop skills and knowledge of the game.

Handbook & Attendance

- Parents & Athlete agree to club handbook and sign agreement stating to abide by club guidelines and expectations.
- Every player is allowed two unexcused absences for a practice or game. Player should notify coach in advance.
 - Missing games and/or practices will result in less playing time.
 - Poor school/classroom performance and/or behavior may result in suspension or removal from the team.
- If a player misses school the day of a practice or game, you are not allowed to participate in basketball when this occurs.
 - o Players attending practices <u>are rewarded</u> for their efforts over players missing practices and/or games.
