Coaches Code

- I will be a positive role model.
- I will conduct myself in a manner that best serves the interest of all players.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice or other youth sporting event.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of a child ahead of any personal desire to win.
- I will insist that we play in a safe and healthy environment.
- I will remember that the game is for children and not for adults.
- I will do my best to make PBFP softball fun for all participants.
- I will expect my players to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect.
- I will encourage teamwork and camaraderie.
- I will continue to learn the game and work to be a better coach for my players.
- I will always be fair and treat everyone equally when discipline is required.
- I will have organized and structured practices.
- I will not use profanity, obscene language or improper actions while coaching.
- I will comply with all decisions of the PBFP Committee and observe all rules, policies and procedures as established by our organizations.
- I will represent PBFP and the communities of Greenville and Hortonville with dignity and professionalism during all games/practices in our community and across the state.
- I will hold myself to a higher standard and will not engage in hostile behavior with opposing fans, coaches or officials.

I also agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines that I will be subject to disciplinary action(s) that could include, but is not limited to the following:
