## Varsity Overview

Tonight brings the official conclusion to the 2012 – 2013 wrestling season – another successful campaign. Continuing tradition in Edwardsville Wrestling is no easy task. The 2012-2013 Tiger Wrestlers challenged themselves to reach the accomplishments of past Tiger Wrestling teams. Most EHS wrestlers put in numerous hours of off-season wrestling and weight training from March – November, giving them an opportunity to reach their goals.

This year's hard work and effort propelled the Tigers to another Southwest Conference Championship. This was the second in a row, and 6<sup>th</sup> out of the last 8 years. This year we had to share the Championship, but the conference was strong as it ever was. The secret to this year's success was depth! As most seasons, with our rigorous schedule, injuries did occur, and many other wrestlers had to step up. Wrestlers were stepping in and out of the line – up all year without a blink. This has been a cornerstone of Edwardsville Wrestling for years. This year was no different, enabling us to finish the regular season 25-2 and rattle off the last 15 regular season matches. The three matches EHS did lose were by a combined 6pts. This means only 6pts off from a perfect season. Not bad! The Tigers placed a respectable 13<sup>th</sup> place in the always tough "Dvorak Tourney" and runner up in the St. Charles West Tournament. A first ever feat was accomplished with EHS's first ever top ten finish in the nationally ranked "Cheesehead Tournament". The Tigers placed 8<sup>th</sup> as everybody contributed, and 7 Tigers placed in the top 9, including Blake Blair's 2<sup>nd</sup> time reaching the Finals. The Tigers put everything together at the end of the season, winning another Regional Championship, and losing a heartbreaker vs. Lincoln Way Central (4<sup>th</sup> in State) at the Dual Team Sectional. The three individuals participating at the State Tournament fell a bit short of their goals, but all wrestled well and competed hard. Individually, Blake Blair has become the most decorated Edwardsville Wrestler in history, setting the career win record and placing top five twice at State. This accomplishment has never been seen at EHS.

This year's team was a heavy dose of Seniors. Nine Seniors all together, along with two Senior Stat girls. Although not all of them represented by being a starter, they all represented their team, and parents well and contributed at one time or another. All the Seniors enjoyed each other's company at practice and many of the trips that we take. It was a tight group that definitely worked hard for each other. There have undoubtedly been many friendships made throughout their years and wrestling career, along with special moments that will never be forgotten. In a career as hard as wrestling, the guys undoubtedly endure ups and downs along the way. The career is filled with learning experiences that will help with further and future endeavors. From a coaches stand point it has been a great ride. **"Remember the Journey"** and never forget that once you are a **Tiger Wrestler, you are always a Tiger Wrestler.**

With such a large group of Seniors departing, filling their spots will be no easy task. Although we are losing 3 state qualifiers and numerous lettermen, the talent that remains in the Tiger Wrestling room is enough to provide another year of excitement. Like in the past, this task can only be accomplished by hard work and dedication that past Tiger Wrestlers have endured. We need to continue to work hard and never forget what got our program to the level that it is at. The off season starts soon, and if not out for another sport – Spring/Summer wrestling and weightlifting should be attended. No matter what your grade level, let's set our goals for surpassing this year's accomplishments. Let's reach what some think is unreachable.

Seniors, thanks again for the effort and memories we all share. Stat girls, thanks for all your hard work and dedication. Coaches – thanks for being the best staff around and dealing with me. To all middle school and EWC coaches, thanks for providing me with the wealth of talent that you do each year, making my job a lot easier. Thanks parents and Booster Club members for enabling my vision for our program to come to fruition and supporting me, Edwardsville Wrestling, and your son. Edwardsville Wrestling is the culmination of many working toward one goal – success, fun, and a memorable journey. I hope these boys have developed into great men ready to take on life's challenges, responsibilities and hardships, and that the great sport of wrestling had something to with it. I would think it has.

## Junior Varsity Overview

The junior varsity team had an outstanding season. Wrestlers and parents should be very proud of what they were able to accomplish on the mats this season. Our coaching staff is very excited about the potential of this group and what their cable of achieving for themselves and the program in the very near future. The loss of many starters from this year's team should be all the motivation they need to have a great off season. Committing themselves to our off season program will allow each of them the opportunity to take the next step in becoming a varsity starter for the TIGERS next season.

This year's team had a dual meet record of 20-0, another very impressive season for a team that was made up of many underclassmen. The team competed in three tournaments this season: Mehlville JV Duals (1<sup>st</sup> Place), Chatham Glenwood Tournament (1<sup>st</sup> Place), and the Southwest Conference JV Tournament (1<sup>st</sup> Place).

The team traveled over Christmas break again this season to compete against some of Missouri's top programs at the Mehlville Duals. Like many teams before them they were ready for the challenge. The team competed extremely hard winning their pool with three victories outscoring their opponents 196 – 30. In the semis the boys continued to show why they were the team to beat by knocking off an undefeated Northwest team 45 – 27. In the finals the TIGERS took on a very good Seckman team that wanted to revenge their only loss from the previous season. The boys were fired up and defeated Seckman 49 – 23 to claim the team championship in TIGER STYLE fashion.

The next test for the JV team was at the Chatham Glenwood Tournament. The team was forced to wrestle this tournament without a full lineup due to injuries and mid season growth by many of their teammates. To win the team championship the boys knew they had to take care of business individually to give themselves a chance in the end. Once again these TIGERS showed their stripes dominating the rest of the field by claiming more individual champions than any other team and placing top three in almost every weight class while on their way to another team title.

The last goal to accomplish as a team on the season was to continue our winning ways at the Southwest Conference JV Tournament. Since it has started we have never loss a dual and this season was no different than years past. The boys swept through the three teams assigned to their pool (Alton 48 – 21, East St. Louis 60 – 21, and Belleville East 51 – 4) to win the Conference Championship. As a team we had twelve individuals in the top four with eight wrestlers in the finals. This was a great way to finish a perfect season of competition.

I would like to thank the parents of all the wrestlers for supporting their sons this season, without your support it would be very difficult to be the team and program we are today. I appreciate the time you allow us to spend with your sons and helping you mold them into great young men of character on and off the mat.

I would also like to thank the senior wrestlers and managers for their hard work, dedication, and passion for the program the past four year. It really means a lot to me and the rest of the coaches that have had a hand in helping you develop in this great sport over your careers. I would like to thank the parents of the seniors for always being there for your sons/daughters, the coaches, and the Edwardsville Wrestling program. I would also like to thank the rest of the coaching staff from the EWC coaches up to the high school staff for your dedication and hard work in helping continue to make Edwardsville Wrestling one of the top programs in the nation.


