

# Program Safety Sheet



PROGRAM NAME: **Roseville Learn to Speedskate**

The following safety sheet has been created to share important information to keep participants and instructors safe. If you have any additional questions, please contact the Program Supervisor:

## Program has been modified:

- *Class will be separated into smaller “pods” (no more than 25 skaters) to follow current guidelines and youth sports restrictions- skaters will remain in these “pods” for the entire LTSS session*
- *Eliminated the use of any commonly touched “training items” during the program*
- *Instructors have adjusted lesson plans to ensure safe social distancing while out on ice*
- *Staff & skaters will be required to wear masks in common areas where social distancing may not be possible (on OVAL bleacher area)*
- **Skaters & Instructors are REQUIRED to wear masks while out on the ice**
- *Skaters MUST come prepared and dressed to enter ice upon arrival to facility*
- *Indoor lobby is ONLY available for restroom usage- skaters to use outdoor bleacher area for putting skates on/off*
- *Skaters allowed to enter facility only 10 minutes prior to skate time and expected to leave the facility 10 minutes following end of session*
- *Skaters enter ice at southeast gate, exit ice at northeast gate (clearly marked with signage)*

## Arrival and Departure Information:

- *All skaters to enter OVAL through the south/main OVAL archway - skaters will proceed down the stairs to use outdoor area for getting skates on/off- masks required*
- *Each “pod” will be assigned a different colored flag, instructors will be located with colored flag around the perimeter/track of the OVAL- skater to skate out to flag once ready*

## Spectator Information:

- *Skaters 9 years of age and older MUST be dropped off and picked up- skaters 8 years of age and younger are only allowed ONE spectator/chaperone to be present*
- **ABSOLUTELY NO ADDITIONAL SPECTATORS ALLOWED TO ENTER OVAL AREA.**
- **Parents/guardians are REQUIRED to keep proper social distancing & are REQUIRED to remain outside**
- *NOTE- there will NOT be any indoor areas for parents/guardians to stay during class, MUST remain outside*

## Basic Cleaning Information:

- *OVAL staff will be disinfecting common touch areas more frequently and after each session- door handles, benches, bathrooms, etc.*

**Facial Covering Information:**

- *All patrons ARE REQUIRED to wear a mask*
- *Skaters are NOW required to wear them while participating in the physical activity of skating*
- *Face coverings are required while outside when moving amongst a larger group of people or when 6ft social distancing is not possible*

It is important to note, that all Roseville Parks and Recreation programs have been planned, developed and conducted following the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and MDH guidelines for Social Distancing in Recreational Programs. Please be aware there is some risk of participating in any activity during the pandemic. Even though we are working to provide as safe as an environment as possible, 100% mitigation cannot be guaranteed for any activity.
