Sport Stable Guidelines

Things to know:

- All Players will enter through the main Sport Stable entrance for each ice session.
- Players should not arrive more than 30 minutes prior to each of their ice sessions.
- Players will check in at the front desk of the Sport Stable and complete the following:
 - o Players will be asked a series of COVID19 exposure and symptom questions at check-in.
 - All players will have their temperature taken each time they enter. Anyone with a reading higher than 100.4 will not be permitted and asked to leave the facility.
 - o Players will complete an emergency contact form
 - Players will be given a locker room assignment upon entering the rink. The players will need to stay in their locker room area until their session begins.
- All players should bring their own water bottle. Please label the water bottle with the player name.
- Locker room showers will not be available for use during any of the tryouts.
- Players need to change and depart the building immediately after their sessions. Players will exit on the South side of the building.

What the Sport Stable is doing to help keep your players safe:

- The Sport Stable is adhering to the Colorado State Mask Order. Please always wear a mask while in the facility. https://drive.google.com/file/d/13S9bLuKZbMVmHPucQnekVyOY2k6gYRa9/view
- COVID19 symptom and temperature checks will be done for all players and coaches.
- Utilizing both rinks and staggering start/stop times to reduce numbers in the building and increase time for thorough sanitizing.
- Using 12-16 designated locker rooms during the tryouts. Locker rooms will have designated spots to allow for social distancing.
- Locker Rooms and common areas will be sanitized between usage.
- There will not be any shared equipment.
- If you forget/do not have a mask, a new one will be provided to you by the Sport Stable front desk staff.
- At this time, the south entrance of the Sport Stable is closed. The south parking lot is open for overflow parking as players are asked to enter through the main entrance.
- First aid items can be found at the front desk.

Parents, unfortunately, the Sport Stable is under a no spectator policy inside the facility due to COVID-19 restrictions placed on the number of people in the building. The Sport Stable restaurant (west entrance, stairs up to the restaurant, ADA access through the main lobby to the elevator) will be open following all social distancing guidelines and restaurant CDC guidelines, so seating is limited, but ordering to-go will be available.
