Gordie Howe Sports Complex (GHSC) Track & Field Facility

Saskatoon Secondary Schools Athletic Directorate is pleased to welcome everyone to the 2023 SHSAA Provincial Track & Field Championship! The following logistics will assist with your preparation. Good Luck!

FACILITY

The Gordie Howe Sports Complex Track & Field facility is located at 1727 Dudley Street which is at the corner of Avenue R and Dudley Street. Please see the map of the entire complex to navigate your arrival.

ADMISSIONS

Admission Gate (Ticket office sales center)

- Adult Admission: \$8.00 per day
- Student Admission: \$6.00 per day (Grade 7-12)

NOTE: Cash, Debit, and Credit cards will be accepted

Programs

- Available free of charge (one per family) at the Admissions Gate while supplies last

Parking

- Parking is provided free of charge in the north lot at the GHSC Track & Field Complex
- Street parking is free on surrounding streets
- Do not block entrances to any surrounding business and homes
 - All City of Saskatoon parking bylaws in effect.
 - Subject to towing and fines
- Overflow parking is available at SMF Field – 1525 Avenue P South (see map)
 - All buses and oversized vehicles must park at SMF Field (see map)
- Athlete/Coach drop off is located on Dudley Street – buses must be east bound on Dudley

NO BUSES IN THE PARKING LOT

REGISTRATION

- Coaches are asked to send their entire athlete delegation through the registration lines rather than the coaches picking up athlete wristbands for their entire team

Athlete Registration - Friday 7:30 AM - 12:00 PM | Saturday 7:30 AM – 10:00 AM

- Athletes and coaches will register at the Athletes and Coaches entrance in the event tent located on the west side of GHSC Track parking lot.
- Upon arrival identify yourself by name and district and you will be directed to the proper table to receive a wrist band that will allow you to enter the park free of charge.
- The wristband must be worn the entire meet.
- Failure to show your admission wristband at the athlete/coach entrance will result in admission being collected at the ticket sales center

Coach Registration - Friday 7:30 AM - 12:00 PM | Saturday 7:30 AM – 10:00 AM

- Coaches will register in the same manner as the athletes (see times and procedures noted above).

Late Registration - Friday after 12:00 PM | Saturday after 10:00 AM

- Late registration Friday and Saturday will occur at the ticket sales center

MEETINGS

Coaches Meeting

- Saturday, June 3 during the track break
- Meeting will occur in the Coach's/Official's meeting room – South end of the second floor of the observation deck.
- District coaches (2 per district) will be provided with free lunch

TRACK & FIELD COMPLEX FACILITY REMINDERS

Track and Infield

- **Athletes and Coaches**
 - Only athletes competing in an event are allowed on the track and infield area
 - May only be on the grass infield by the instruction of an official
 - Coaches – set a good example for our athletes in this regard
- **Spectators**
 - Use the middle doors on the ground floor of the K & S Multi-Sports Center Building to access seating
 - **Absolutely no spectators allowed on the track, infield, and marshalling area**

NOTE: Footballs and frisbees will not be allowed on site for the duration of the event

Tarmac in front of the bleachers

- This area is for transit and must be kept clear at all times

Finish Line

- Please keep this area clear while races are underway on the track
- Follow the stop signs at the finish line

Second floor observation deck is available for:

- Coaches/Officials meetings
- Photo finish personnel
- Meet officials and volunteers
- Preferred spectator seating – arranged at the ticket office
- **Absolutely no athletes on the second floor**

Tents

- Only SSSAD and SHSAA tents allowed on the skirting of the field
- All other tents must be in the athlete village

Athletes Village (See Map)

- Glenn Reeve #8 will be used as an athlete village for both days of the competition
- This will be accessed through the north end of the Athlete/Coach registration tent area
- Athletes/Districts will be able to set up tents in this area
- Tents must be taken down on Friday night
- Please keep the area clean by putting all garbage into the trash receptacles

NOTE: Supervision of this area is the responsibility of the districts.

Washrooms and changerooms

- Washrooms are located on the north end of the K & S Multi-Sports Center Building
- Changerooms are located on the main floor of the K & S Multi-Sports Center Building
 - Follow the signage near the bleachers

Concessions – both days

- The concession, located on the north side of the K & S Multi-Sports Center Building, will be open both days
- Three food trucks will be located on the tarmac inside the GHSC track Complex during the two days of competition
- Additional food trucks may be on Dudley Street

MEET DETAILS

Marshalling of Athletes

- Field events will be marshalled at the event site
- Track events will be marshalled at the marshalling tent located at the 100m start line (Southeast corner of the track)
 - Athletes' belongings will be transported by volunteers from the start line to the finish line for the hurdles, 100m, and 200m events

Medal and Ribbon Presentations

- Field Events
 - At the conclusion of each field event, the head official will be requested to bring the top competitors (1st – 8th) to the Awards tent
 - The head official will give the results sheet to the results runners who will take the sheets to the announcers' booth
 - Ribbons will be presented to finishers 4 – 8 while medals will be presented to the top 3
- Track Events
 - Within 30 minutes of the conclusion of each track event, the top 8 competitors will be called to the Awards tent and Podium for presentations

NOTE: Please remind your athletes they must wear their District uniform for award presentations

Medical Treatment

- Summit Sports and Health will be providing care throughout the event and will be located near the high jump pits on the north end of the facility
- Summit Sports and Health will not be treating/taping pre-existing injuries
 - All coaches should equip themselves with the standard first-aid supplies **including tape**, as with any other activity

Schedule and Results

- All event heats/sessions can be found on Athletic Live
- All results will be posted to Athletic Live

NOTE: Athletic Live - Linked to the [SHSAA](#) and [SSSAD](#) website accessible via QR Code (found at the gate and at various points around the facility)

Merchandise Sales - Sport Logo

- Sport Logo will be set up in the Athletes Village
- Poor weather location – Sport Logo will move to the ground floor of the Track & Field Complex Building

SaskMilk

- All athletes will receive SaskMilk products free of charge throughout the competition
- Milk distribution will occur at the North End of the facility near the awards tent and athlete village
