

Essential Information For Players and Parents

In order for players to attend official tryouts or practices, players will need the following:

- Be completely registered
- Turn in a signed copy of "Attendance Policy" to the coaches
- Turn in a signed copy of "Consent to Treat" to coaches; if you turned one in at Fall Ball, you do NOT have to sign another, good for the entire school year

Registration

- US Lacrosse updated through 6/1/2019 (\$35)
- Utah Lacrosse Paid (\$100)
- Park City Paid (\$600 for fees, \$150 for apparel, \$200 for volunteer fee)
- \$100 late charge if registered after 1/16
- Additional costs for travel will be assessed closer to travel date (approx. \$450 for varsity trip, \$250 for JV trip, and \$50 for F/S tournament)

Tryouts

- In order to be assured the best team placement, players are strongly encouraged to attend as many tryout days as possible.
- The only acceptable excuse for missing tryouts will be commitments to another team, with that said multiport athletes must attend at least one to be considered for Varsity. If you're unable to attend any date you will not be starting the season on the Varsity roster. In this case, players will have a chance to "play on" to a desired level. This will be up to the coaches' discretion.

Volunteer/Fundraising (Player Responsibilities)

- All players are expected to participate in ALL fundraisers.
- Trees-Players will help with distribution and marketing efforts. Players will sign up for at least one day to pick up trees the weekends of 12/29-12/30 and 1/5-1/6
- All players will sell at least 10 car wash cards. Players are responsible for the monetary value of their 10 car wash cards. Players will be billed for cards that are lost or not returned.
- Players who sell more than 10 car wash cards will be entered into a drawing for gift cards.
- Players are expected to secure 1 sponsorship. Players who secure more than 1 sponsorship will be entered into a drawing for gift cards.

Volunteer (Parent Responsibilities)

- Parent help is essential to the success of the program
- Parents will pay a \$200 deposit, returnable at the end of year banquet if volunteer hours are fulfilled
- Each family must volunteer 10 hours during the season, no partial refunds will be given.
- Each family will be responsible to update their volunteer hours on a team document.
- Volunteer opportunities will be sent out in a digital format
