

Alexandria High School Hockey Tryout Process



Boys and Girls

8th Grade

Age eligible for youth hockey process to participate in HS hockey

- → Players will try out for Bantam/U15.
- → Players will be placed on a roster and participate.
- → Invited only by the head HS coach upon completion of AAHA tryouts to try out for the HS program.
- → If invited to tryout for the HS, players may return to AAHA after HS tryouts and participate for the team they were rostered with.

9th grade

Age eligible for youth hockey process to participate in HS hockey

- → Players will try out for Bantam/U15.
- → Players will be placed on a roster and participate.
- → After AAHA tryouts, HS coaches will invite selected players to tryout for HS
- → If invited to tryout for the HS, players may return to AAHA after HS tryouts and participate for the team they were rostered with.

If a player stays at High School after being rostered on a youth hockey team, AAHA may decide to move players from the B team to the A/AA team.

10th grade

Age eligible for youth hockey process to participate in HS hockey

- → 10th graders who are age eligible for AAHA will have the choice to register and try out for AAHA.
- → After AAHA tryouts they will be placed on an AAHA roster and participate.
- → After AAHA tryouts, a 10th grade player can tryout for the HS team and may return to AAHA after HS tryouts and participate for the team they were rostered with for AAHA.
 - This would take place if the athlete tries out for the HS program and is <u>not offered</u> a roster spot

**If an AAHA eligible player does not participate in AAHA tryouts but does go through the HS tryout process and is not provided a HS roster spot, they can still play for AAHA and will be placed on the lowest team at their age level.

If a player stays at High School after being rostered on a youth hockey team, AAHA may decide to move players from the B team to the A/AA team.

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
