



Phase 4 Game Protocols

Coaches and Team Officials must police their respective teams for protocol enforcement

- South Entrance (Locker room doors) must be used by all players and coaches.
- Players may not arrive to the facility more than 30 minutes prior to game time.
- All players & coaches must enter the building wearing a face covering.
- Coaches must wear a face covering the entire time while in the Ice Arena (Including the player bench)
- Players must wear the face covering until game time and must replace it immediately after the game, this includes the locker room.
- Players must come to facility fully dressed, skates and helmets may be put on in the assigned locker room.
- Goalies may dress fully in the locker room.
- Players and coaches must leave the facility promptly after the game. No Linger around.
- There is one (1) spectator limit per player.
- Spectators may use the West (Main Entrance)
- Spectators must wear a face covering the entire time while in the facility.

Many of these protocols are in place for your safety and the safety of the Winnetka Ice Arena Staff.

No Zamboni Drivers = Facility Closure

If you do not feel your organization can follow these protocols, including policing the opposing organization, please refrain from scheduling games at the Winnetka Ice Arena. We will be checking both live and video recordings that the protocols are being enforced. Failure to follow protocols will result in canceling future contests and rental time at the Winnetka Ice Arena.
