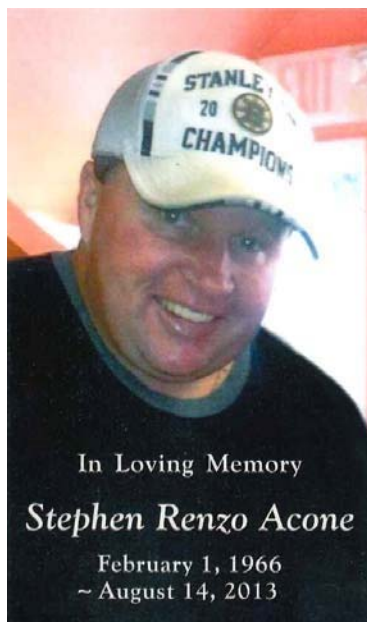

# Stephen Acone Scholarship



Stephen "Punky" Acone was born and raised in Winthrop. His true love was hockey and he was the original "rink rat". Stephen known to his friends, coworkers, and teammates as Punky was a member of the 1975 Squirt New England Championship Team. He later graduated from Winthrop High School where he played hockey for the Vikings. He was a member of the 1984 and 1985 Northeastern Conference Title Winners. In 1985 Stephen was selected as a North Eastern Conference All-Star. Stephen coached with Winthrop Youth Hockey for many years and played as an adult for the Elks in the Winthrop Senior League. Stephen 2<sup>nd</sup> home was the rink and he could always be found there.

After working for the Suffolk County Sheriff Department for 9 years in 1993 he was hired by the Winthrop Police Department fulfilling a lifelong dream.

Stephen's service to the town, Winthrop Youth Hockey Association and the game of hockey for more than 40 years was a reflection of his ability, dedication, and interest in volunteering to the town he loved so much. We celebrate and honor Stephen by dedicating this tournament to him to raise money for his scholarship to Winthrop High School graduating senior and former players for Winthrop Youth Hockey.

# Michael Delehanty Scholarship



Detective Michael “Mike” Delehanty was 58 when he passed on this year. He had been out of work since July 2017 when he suffered a cardiac arrhythmia while on duty. He served as a police officer for 25 years and as a union electrical worker for more than 36 years.

Detective Delehanty was known as a strong yet gentle street cop with a fierce loyalty to the citizens of Winthrop. He earned a reputation for always extending a helping hand to anyone in need.

In recent years, Detective Delehanty served as the Winthrop Police Prosecutor at East Boston District Court. He was also a dedicated volunteer who was recently given a community service award for his more than 20 years of service to Winthrop Advocacy,

Resources, Community (WINARC) and for organizing the annual Driscoll-Mahegan Track and Field event in town. He was a natural organizer and was the department’s go-to person for event planning and community events.

Detective Delehanty was the long-term president of the Winthrop Police Association, a member of the Winthrop Yacht Club, the Winthrop Patrolman’s Union and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local #103.

He also earned a reputation as a “worker” in the department, often working long hours to ensure he could provide a good life for his six children and one grandson.
