

SCHOOL DISTRICT OF KETTLE MORAINE TOURNAMENT

RELEASE FORM

Player participation in any Kettle Moraine or KMBBC Basketball tournament constitutes automatic acceptance of the following indemnity, release, and waiver terms by the player and legal guardian of the player:

- Participation (releaser) in any Kettle Moraine basketball game hereby release, waives, and discharges the School District of Kettle Moraine, Kettle Moraine Boys Basketball Club, it's basketball teams, its officers and members, volunteers, officials, working participants, owners and lessees of the premises, their offices and employees)here referred to as releases) from all liability to the participant. The releaser, legal representatives, heirs and assigns, for any and all loss or damage, and any claim or damages resulting there from, on account of injury to participant's person or property, even injury resulting in death of the participant, whether caused by the negligence of the releases or otherwise while participant is for any purpose participating in basketball practices or games.
- Releaser agrees to indemnify the releases from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur due to the presence of participant in any Kettle Moraine or KMBBC basketball tournament, whether cause by the negligence of the releases or otherwise.
- Releaser herby assumes full responsibility for the risk of bodily injury, death or property damage due to the negligence of the releases or otherwise while in or upon the school premises of Kettle Moraine.
- Releaser expressly agrees that this release, waiver and indemnity is intended to be a broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Wisconsin, and that if any portion thereof is held to be invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue to be in full legal force and effect.

Releaser acknowledges that all participants will adhere to the State of Wisconsin Concussion Law At the beginning of a season for a youth athletic activity, the person operating the youth athletic activity shall distribute a concussion and head injury information sheet to each person who will be coaching that youth athletic activity and to each person who wishes to participate in that youth athletic activity. No person may participate in a youth athletic activity unless the person returns the information sheet signed by the person and, if he or she is under the age of 19, by his or her parent or guardian.
