

# Volunteer Role Description Bantam Director – Buffalo Youth Hockey Association (BYHA)

## **Purpose**

Oversee and elevate the BYHA Bantam program, ensuring every player develops safely, competitively, and with a passion for the game as they transition to high-school hockey.

## **Key Responsibilities**

Program Strategy & Player Development	<ul> <li>Work with Player Development and coaches to create age-appropriate development goals that balance skill progression, team systems, and hockey IQ.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Promote safe body-checking techniques and USA Hockey concussion-prevention protocols.</li> </ul>
Coaching Selection & Support	Recruit, interview, and recommend head and assistant coaches for all Bantam teams with a strong focus on bringing in non-parent coach options
	<ul> <li>Provide coaches with resources, mentorship, and mid-season evaluations.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Encourage continued education (e.g., checking-certification clinics).</li> </ul>

### Team Leveling, Rostering & Tryouts

- Partner with BYHA Tryout Coordinators and the HOC VP/Hockey Director to build the tryout schedule, evaluation criteria, and on-ice flow.
- Oversee evaluations for fair, transparent placements into the appropriate skill tiers.
- Communicate results and next steps promptly to families.

# Pre-Season Conditioning & Clinics

- Organize off-ice conditioning recommendations and on-ice skill sessions before tryouts.
- Secure ice times, coaches, and training resources.

## Tournament & Schedule Planning

- Coordinate with the Tournament Coordinator to select competitive events that fit team caliber and budget.
- Review game-count balance (league vs. tourney vs. scrimmage) to manage player fatigue.

## Discipline & Code of Conduct

- Serve as the first point of contact for any Bantam-level disciplinary issues (players, parents, coaches).
- Enforce BYHA policies and USA Hockey sportsmanship guidelines.

## Parent & Player Communication

- Lead pre-season and mid-season parent meetings.
- Send regular updates on program progress, expectations, and key dates.

# Program Leadership & Reporting

- Present Bantam program status and needs at monthly HOC meetings.
- Track budgets (clinics, resources, tournaments) and submit requests.

• Collaborate with Squirt/Peewee directors to ensure smooth player progression.

### **Ideal Qualifications**

- Deep knowledge of Bantam-age hockey development and safety standards.
- Prior coaching or hockey-operations experience.
- Strong organizational skills with the ability to juggle multiple teams and timelines.
- Excellent communicator—clear, confident, and approachable.
- Collaborative leader who builds trust with volunteers, board members, and families.

### **Time Commitment**

- **Peak season (Aug-Mar):** ~6–8 hrs/week (tryouts, practices, games/tourneys, meetings).
- Off-season (Apr-Jul): ~2 hrs/week (planning, outreach, coach recruitment).
- Two-year term recommended for continuity.

### **Reporting & Collaboration**

- Reports to: BYHA Hockey Operations Committee (HOC) VP / Hockey Director
- Works closely with: Bantam team coaches, Tryout Coordinators, Tournament Coordinator, Registrar, Treasurer, Ice Scheduler, and Communications Lead.
