## Tea Parks and Recreation Policy for Rosters

Due to the complexity of doing rosters and schedules with a high number of participants, and multiple schools and towns. As a department we WILL NOT be taking roster requests.

## How does Tea Parks \& Recreation Split Up Teams for Recreation Programs?

- This way is how do rosters for most programs, but not all Tea Rec. Programs

1. Put them in the correct Division/Gender Group

- Example: 8 U Boys $\& 8 \mathrm{U}$ Girls

2. Put at least two participants from the same grade and same school (if applicable) on the same team.

## Example

| First Name | Last Name | School | Grade | Division |

| Clark | Kent | Venture Elem. | $1^{\text {st }}$ | 8U Boys |
| Bruce | Wayne | Venture Elem. | $1^{\text {st }}$ | 8U Boys |
| Steve | Rogers | Frontier Elem. | $2^{\text {nd }}$ | 8U Boys |
| Tony | Stark | Frontier Elem. | $2^{\text {nd }}$ | 8U Boys |

## Exceptions to the Policy:

1. Siblings (brothers \& sisters) will always be paired on the same team if they're in the same division and gender group.
2. A volunteer coach make's a request to co-coach with another parent. Then both of their kids will be on the same team.

- We can only take one request to coach with one other coach. This is to make sure we don't have a team that has 4 coaches on one team, while another only has 1 coach.
