- I have emailed Paul Syzmanski again, waiting for his response to WMYBA's donation of the shot clock's covering our facilities for 2022-2023.
- Start to brainstorm around summer opportunities for WMYBA
 - Last year we did a K-3 camp June 14-17, open gyms the last two Wednesday's in July and tryouts were August 9 & 10, Boys minicamp in Sept with some open gyms and Girls minicamp in October. Mike H intends to run K-3 camp again this summer, maybe the week of June 13-16. (Monday thru Thursday) We will look for additional times for open gyms this summer morning or afternoon are options and Jeff O is interested in conducting them.
 - We'd have time in Sept for open gyms
 - Henry Janikula (10th next year) expressed an interest in running an open gym with drills for kids and he's going to email me with an outline and timeframe he's thinking. Dave O. will continue to pursue what Henry's plan is regarding age group and plan for the group.

- Tentative dates for 22-23 tournaments are:

- Boys 02-25-23 & 02-26-23 we are still deciding if we want 3rd grade to play with girls as we did last year or with boys and include on Sunday with 4 & 5 grades. The board will review these dates prior to the next meeting and predict any conflicts with neighboring tournaments.

Registration for 2022-2023 season (Gordon):

• Should we alter registration fees? K-2 \$85, 3^{rd} \$100, 4^{th} - 8^{th} \$175, plus \$100 deposit. The board unanimously agreed to increase fees for the 22-23 season to, \$5 for K-3 and \$10 for 4^{th} through 8^{th} grades. Fees to be, K-2 \$90, 3^{rd} grade \$110, 4^{th} – 8^{th} grades \$185.

- When do we open Basketball season registration? Last year June 1. Open May 1st
 - Establish timeline for registration, signage, registration close, coach's procurement, apparel orders and season. Gordon will create a google Doc that the board can create this timeline.

In 22-23 we will look at more consolidation of WM teams for tournaments to get more WM teams at the same tourneys, pay for all the teams at once and hopefully capture potential discounts at the same time for boys and girls.
