1. Drop Back Date and Event Specialist Declaration.
  - a. Moved to establish a Drop Back Date, and declare Individual Event Specialist for the 2018 competition season, to be the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday after the 2<sup>nd</sup> weekend of February.

3. Montana State Championships – March 17-19, 2017 at Carroll College.
  - a. Online registration is underway. Currently, 344 entries have been submitted. We are anticipating 450-475 athletes to participate in the State Meet Championships.
  - b. Moved to award all around medals to all participants, and award top 60% placements on each individual event on all Levels 2-10 and Xcel.
