## Bemidji PW B1 Tournament Format and Rule Supplement

Bemidji's PWB1 Tournament consists of 12 teams. Teams will be placed into 4 pools. Teams will play two Pool Games and then be seeded in their pool after pool play is complete on Saturday morning. Part of the reason for the departure from our commonly used pool play format is to accommodate the BCA Rink Schedule due to two high school games occurring that day. Another purpose of this formatting is to provide teams with an opportunity to continue to compete for the Championship, even if they do not finish first in their pool.

The teams will then be placed into the bracketing format below for Saturday night and Sunday games. For ease of bracket determination, there will be no cross-pool seeding to determine placement in the brackets. \#1 Seeds will play \#2 Seeds and \#3 Seeds will play \#3 Seeds in the first round of bracket play as indicated below. Coaches and Team managers should notify tournament personnel if a game runs late, so the schedule can be adjusted to accommodate the two-hour rest period, but the current schedule accommodates this. The bracket games will follow BYHA overtime and shootout procedures.
