INTERESTING NOTE: OUR POST OFFICE IS A MESS



An audit by the U.S. Postal Service Office of Inspector General found residents of Colorado mountain towns experienced significantly lower ontime performance than the rest of the state and country.

The audit published Tuesday, Dec. 5, by the U.S. Postal Service's Office of Inspector General was initiated after customers, local leaders and lawmakers have called attention to postal issues across the Western Slope in recent years.

The issues with customers receiving their mail on time grew so acute in some mountain towns last winter that several local governments publicly discussed legal action against the U.S. Postal Service. Some residents at the time reported issues accessing medications and important bills through the mail since packages and letters would show up weeks or months late.

The audit identifies hiring and retention of employees to be the biggest challenge for the U.S. Postal Service facilities in Colorado mountain towns. A lack of management oversight, communication and insufficiently trained postmasters also contributed, in part, to the lower service performance and customer service, according to the audit,

Currently, Vail Run typically receives mail only 4 days a week, and generally between 4:30 and 7:00PM. We often receive mail that does not belong to Vail Run or business in the building, we suspect some of our mail goes elsewhere. We just learned our current temporary carrier is headed to California next week.
