

ANGBC Tip-off Classic Tournament Rules

1. 3 Game Guarantee

2. Awards will be given for 1st and 2nd place

- a. Team awards will be limited to 12 players per team

3. Time

- a. All Grades: 2-18 minute halves
 - i. Running clock except for final 2 minutes of each half
- b. Three full timeouts per game. One additional timeout for each team in each overtime period
- c. 5 minute warmup between games
- d. 5 minute halftime
- e. Overtime
 - i. 3 minute overtime with clock stopping on each whistle. If still tied after 2nd overtimes, the 10 players on the floor will shoot 1 free throw each. Home team on the scoreboard will shoot first, guest will shoot second.

4. Defense

- a. Grades 3-6: Man to Man only-2nd violation results in 2 points awarded to the opponent
- b. Grades 7-8: Any defense is allowed

5. Pressing

- a. Grade 3: No pressing allowed
- b. Grade 4: Pressing allowed the last minute of each half and the last minute of overtime, unless up by 20 or more points
- c. Grades 5-6: Pressing allowed the last 2 minutes of each half and the last minute of overtime, unless up by 20 or more points
- d. Grades 7-8: Anytime, unless up by 20 or more points

6. Free Throws

- a. Grades 3 and 4 will shoot from the 13 foot line. They may go over the line.
- b. Grade 5 will shoot from the 15 foot line. They may go over the line.
- c. Grades 6-8: Normal free throw rules apply.

7. Technical Fouls

- a. 1st technical foul will result in automatic 2 points and the ball for the other team. 2nd technical foul will result in 2 points for the other team and ejection from the game.

8. Tie Breaker (if necessary)

- a. Best Record
- b. Head to Head
- c. Points Allowed
- d. Point Differential

9. Miscellaneous

- a. Any team canceling their entry, 2 weeks before they are scheduled to play, will not be issued a refund.
 - b. No All-Star or AAU teams allowed.
 - c. Players must have matching jerseys with numbers on the front and back.
 - d. Bring your own basketballs for warm-ups.
 - e. Score keepers will be provided.
 - f. All other WIAA rules are in effect. No protests. The Referees rulings are final.
 - g. The AASD and the ANCBC will not be responsible for any personal injury of any player, coach or spectator. They will also not be held responsible for any lost or stolen items.
 - h. Full concession stand will be available. Please no carry-ins.
 - i. The tournament director will make the final decisions on all matters that are not covered.
