FILLING OUT THE SHEET DURING THE GAME

Shots on goal: A “shot on goal” is any shot that would have gone in the goal if a goalie was not there. Shots where the goalie makes a save outside of the net/post that would not have gone in, and shots that hit the post and bounce away are not considered a “shot on goal”.

Shots can be marked by a “dot” or an “X”, but should be marked at the location from where the shot was taken

Goals should be circled

Keep track of which goalie is on which side, either by team (example “EM” for East Metro) or by goalie jersey number

Record the number of Saves (S) and Goals (G) by period, by goalie

The number of saves should be equal to the number of shots minus the number of goals

FILLING OUT THE SHEET DURING THE GAME

Keeping track of the scoring: All scoring will be reported by the referees. The ref will come to the score box and say something like "goal, white (scoring team's jersey color), #3, assisted by #19 and #20"

Record the period of the goal

Record the time remaining from the score board

Record the number of the player who scored

Record which team scored the goal ("EM" for East Metro)

Record the number of the player(s) who assisted

Keeping track of the penalties: All penalties will be reported by the referees. The ref will come to the score box and say something like "one minute penalty, #10, white (player's jersey color), for slashing"

Record the period of the penalty

Record the player number

Record the length of the penalty
Note: Most penalties should be 1:00 min

Record the time they came off the ice

Record the time they went back on the ice
Note: This could be less than the length of the penalty if a goal was scored

Record the team ("EM" for East Metro)
