

HASL Hall of Fame Policy [Adopted by HASL Board 2019]

Eligibility

- Nominee must have been a member of the league for 10 seasons, and they do not have to be consecutive seasons. [Our Spring league is one season]
- The nominee – whether a player, manager, coach, scorekeeper, umpire, or sponsor – should have made significant contributions to the league and have been actively involved in HASL league or league events. (added by HASL Board vote on April 10th, 2024)
- ~~Nominee must be active and in “Good” standing with HASL, NAGAAA or/and ASANA.~~ (Was removed by a unanimous HASL Board vote on Wednesday, February 10th, 2021)
- Nominee can be a Player, Non-Player, or a Team.
- Special considerations, outside the eligibility requirements, must be presented and approved by the HASL Board. This requirement shall be used only to recognize a nominee for extraordinary efforts within the league.

Nomination

- Nominations shall be allowed from any active member of HASL or member of HASL HOF.
- Nominations are confirmed by the HOF committee.
- A call for potential nominations will be sent to the HASL membership no later than June 1st.
- Nominations for the current year must be submitted by July 1st.
- The HOF committee will be responsible for sending bios and voting information to all eligible voters (see Definitions section below)
- Votes will be submitted to the committee via email OR electronic ballot no later than July 20th.
- **HASL Board AND HOF COMMITTEE SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR KEEPING AN ACCURATE DATABASE OF HASL HOF MEMBERS WITH THEIR EMAIL ADDRESS**
- ***Dates may be reviewed/updated by the HOF Committee each season**

Voting

- Once votes are received, the HOF committee will tally the totals.
- Induction to HASL HOF shall be determined by a majority vote of $\frac{2}{3}$ or **66.7%** of the RESPONDING HASL Voting Committee
- HOF Committee will be responsible for notifying the nominator of the newly elected HOF member FIRST and then they will notify the newly elected HASL HOF member.
- Newly elected HASL HOF member(s) will be announced at the closing ceremonies and later recognized at the HASL HOF event.

Definitions:

- HOF Voting Committee is:

- 1.) Current HASL HOF members
- 2.) Current HASL Board members
- 3.) Current HASL Coaches Council

*Each individual is permitted only 1 vote per HASL HOF nominee
