Presentation of Minutes

Motion to approve May meeting minutes with corrections of the amount in the saving account, motion was made by Gina Mendoza. Seconded by Suzanne Wolf; motion passed. Savings account was adjusted with subtraction of \$125.73, which brings the total of \$10,006.62 for the account balance.
