Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Is there a limit to the number of players we can have on a team? No, a floating roster as availability of players is typically hit and miss with other sports and school activities in fall.
- 2. Do we need releases for those coming from Little League or other associations? No, however any out of catchment players can not be added before September 1st(without release). The current period release period end date August 31st. These players will need to be advised that they are property of their home association and the release rules will be in effect January 1.
- 3. Are we allowed only 3 imports like in the spring/summer? Currently unlimited as all associations don't run fall ball.
- 4. Those players who didn't play during the spring/summer, are they eligible for fall? How does that work with insurance? Insurance runs from April 1 to March 31. Any new players will have to be added and Anne Hayes advised and fee submitted.
- 5. There doesn't seem to be any forms for BC Baseball...do we have to let them know we are fielding a team for this season? You can advise the division director your intentions so they are aware. For coordination of games your best bet would be to contact your spring interlock coordinator for contact list.
