# Cookie Dough Fundraiser USEFUL TIDBITS & FAQ

#### **Useful Tidbits:**

- © Check out the Cookie Dough flavors and ingredients in the **BROCHURE**
- Print this <u>ORDER FORM</u> at home to keep track of your orders. Ensure your player notes who purchases, where to deliver their order when it comes in, and how much they have ordered. Your player will be delivering the cookie dough to their customers when it comes in! Please keep a copy of your orders.
- © Encourage your player or skater to call, email or FaceTime neighbors, friends, and families to share why it is important to support our non-profit and our mission of building players and skaters for life plus why hockey or skating is important to them.
- Money for the order MUST be collected at the time of sale. Should a customer wish to pay by credit card please guide them to the website page <a href="https://www.snokinghockey.com/cookiedough">www.snokinghockey.com/cookiedough</a> to complete their order and pay. Do not forget to let them know your "player or skater name" to complete their order. If family or friends live out of town, they can still support with an online donation.
- Total your orders and submit one consolidated order online with payment to Sno-King (credit card, cash or check made out to Sno-King Amateur Hockey Association). All orders must be submitted online to provide detailed order tracking and reporting.
- © Keep a copy of your detailed order form "by customer" so you know who to deliver it to upon arrival.
- © Cougar Mountain will deliver Sno-King's consolidated order to our Sno-King facilities for players and skaters to pick-up on December 5 and 6. We will schedule and communicate pickup details after Thanksgiving once all orders are submitted. We are unable to ship to any location other than a Sno-King facility.
- ② Players and Skaters will then be responsible for distributing to those who ordered from them. Please remember, it must be kept cold make sure to sell to those you can easily deliver to and or you have fridge/freezer space ready for storage.

# **Frequently Asked Questions**

### Is Sno-King a non-profit?

Yes, Sno-King is a 501c3 non-profit organization.

#### How are the funds being used?

Funds will be used to keep program fees as low as possible, provide financial assistance to participants who qualify, improve the quality of service with new programs such as our coaches' club, and invest in equipment and facilities upgrades.

### Why is it stated that 50% of the proceeds are going to be used?

Cougar Mountain Baking Company offers non-profits the ability to fundraise by selling their products at a cost of \$20 per tub. Sno-King is responsible to pay Cougar Mountain Baking Company \$10 to cover the cost of the dough, the rest will be fully reinvested in our abovementioned initiatives.

### How do I place my consolidated order if I sold tubs to family and friends?

All consolidated orders are to be placed online <u>here</u> before October 28<sup>th</sup>. We provided paper copies of the order tracking form to help you keep track of your customers' individual orders and payments. Please keep a copy of your orders for easy delivery.

### How do I place a personal order?

You can place a personal order online here before October 28th.

### How can someone donate in lieu of purchasing cookie dough?

Anyone can donate on our website <u>here</u>. We suggest a \$40 donation to help us achieve our goal. In addition, corporate matching donations are another terrific way to double your impact.

## How do I designate a skater/player to receive credit for my order?

# When does the cookie dough arrive?

The cookie dough will be delivered to our Sno-King facilities between December 5 and 6. Youth hockey teams will be responsible for picking up their orders and delivering them to their customers. All other orders will receive pick up details in early December.
