- 7U (2018) to 19U (2006) - \$10.00
- 20U (2005) and Older - \$6.00
- Volunteers & Managers – No Fee

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# 2025-26 Season Requirements

- It's important that all players in your Association are claimed in your Porta including, Learn to Skate
- Association Board Roster required prior to any team being approved.
  - Individual titles have been pre-loaded
  - Individual with coaching numbers, if title is not populated the it can be created using custom
- Birth Certificates and Citizenship must be verified prior to roster being approved.
- SafeSport Training required for 2008 birth years and older.

# 2025-26 Roster Requirements

- Head Coach
- Team Manager
- Locker Room Monitor
  - One Locker Room Monitor is required to be present at each game
  - Suggest designating all coaches as Locker Room Monitors
- Position and Jersey numbers for all 10U and Older teams
- 14U AA classification, Tier I and Tier II, no team may roster any player 12 years of age or under
- No more than three (3) players who reside outside the District 6 except for 16U & 18U which is unlimited

# 2025-26 Roster Requirements

- Coaches must have current age specific module
- CEP must be current by December 31<sup>st</sup> or will be removed from the roster
- 6U/8U & Learn to Skate new CEP for new coaches
- Student coaches must have the new 6U/8U CEP
  - Must wear a helmet and neck laceration protection, even when on the bench
- CEP Level 1 good for five years as long as they are not coaching at a higher level
- Level 4 good for three seasons and Level 5 for four seasons

# Roster Sizes

- Roster size 20 Players including 2 Goalies
  - Maximum of 18 Skaters
- Tier 1 22 Players including 2 Goalies
  - 15O , 16U, 18U & Tier 1 19U Girls, Maximum of 20 Skaters
- JV may roster up to 25 players between September 1<sup>st</sup> and November 14<sup>th</sup> but after November 15<sup>th</sup> are limited to 20 players but are not required to release any of the players
- High School roster limit is 30 players but only allowed to dress 20
- Tier I and Tier II National Bound Teams must have a minimum of 15 players
- Post Season roster limit is 25 until August 31<sup>st</sup> but only allowed to dress 20

# Season Start Dates

- August 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Split Season
  - Pre-Season High School
  - Tier I
  - Tier II 14U – 19U Regular Season
- September 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Travel (Tier II) & Tier III
    - Tier III Teams must adhere to the MAHA draft rules
- April 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Spring/Summer Season - Players, who are rostered on a Regular Season team still active in the current season, may not sign (or practice) another team's roster for an upcoming Pre/Post season or spring/summer season team until the team they are currently rostered on has completed their season.

# Split Season Teams

- Coded as Regular Season Teams
- Allowed to be either National or Non Bound
  - Teams Participating in October Tournament must be National Bound
- To participate in the October MAHA State Tournament must be registered by September 1<sup>st</sup> Winner advances to Nationals
- Game Count, 20 for team and 10 for each player prior to the start of the MAHA State Championship Tournament in October
- Players must be released after the conclusion of the tournament
- Championship team roster is frozen and coded dormant and reactivated for National Tournament
- Player can only be on one National Bound Team

# Releasing Players

- A player signed to an approved team roster must secure a release in writing from that team before signing with another team, and roster approved at least 72 hours in advance of playing in a game.

- Player releases, unless requested by the player, cannot be made later than November 30 of the current playing season.
- No players can be added to a team's roster after December 23<sup>rd</sup> of the current playing season to be eligible for District, State and National tournaments.

# Tournament Teams

- During the regular season September 1<sup>st</sup> to April 1<sup>st</sup> Youth and Girls Tier III players may roster a tournament team.
- Only Tier III Players are allowed
- Tier I and Tier II and Travel players may roster a tournament team after the completion of the player's regular season and before April 1<sup>st</sup>.

# Invitation Tournament, Jamboree or Showcase

- If your program is planning on hosting an invitational tournament, Jamboree or Showcase you are required to apply for a USA Hockey Tournament sanction

- \$350 Application Fee and \$45 per team, deducted from registration fee
- \$350 - 3 on 3 or 4 on 4 Tournaments with no per team fee
- \$350 – Showcase \$500 for six or more teams
- \$50 – 8U Jamboree

# Game Counts

- The following exceptions to the game count table apply:
- a. Games played in District, State and National tournaments, in classifications where these are held shall not count toward the game count.
- b. For ages 10U and older, all tournaments shall count for four (4) games maximum regardless of the actual number of games played

- Zero Club – No goals scored against goalie in a single game
- Only One Patch per Category per Season
