



### **11v11 Virtual**

#### **Course Details:**

The 11v11 In-Person Course is a four-hour course that builds on the principles covered in U.S. Soccer's Introduction to Grassroots Coaching Module. Specifically, coaches will learn more about U.S. Soccer's Grassroots Coaching Education Philosophy, Play-Practice-Play Methodology, the Six Tasks of a Coach, and the characteristics of players aged 13 and older. The course will also ask each coach to reflect on their experiences to develop action steps for personal growth in the Six Tasks (Coaching Games, Coaching Training Sessions, Leading the Team, Leading the Player, Managing the Performance Environment, and Leadership).

Coaches who take this completely virtual course will be guided by a licensed instructor through four (4) hours total of education. Coaches can expect two (2) hours of virtual interaction to discuss the Six Tasks, Grassroots Coaching Education Philosophy, and Play-Practice-Play Methodology followed by two (2) hours of video analysis (guided by the instructor) of demonstrations of on-field coaching for this specific age group.

Coaches will be asked to participate in discussions so each person should have access to a web-camera/live video capabilities.

#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

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### **11v11 Traditional**

#### **Course Details:**
