



WARREN YOUTH FOOTBALL PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

- I/We will practice good sportsmanship and maintain a proper perspective for youth sports.
- I/We will not allow my self-interest or personal goals to undermine the fundamental principles of the Warren Youth Football (WYF) or The Chicagoland Youth Football League (TCYFL) Communities.
- I/We will make every effort to participate in practices and games with the required equipment. If unable, I will notify the coach.
- I/We will not use or be under the influence of any Tobacco, Alcohol or Illegal drugs on the game, practice field, stands or facility of a WYF sponsored event.
- I/We will not allow or encourage any other person to engage in un-sportsmanship conduct towards any coach, parent, player, participant, official, other attendee or representative of the WYF or TCYFL.
- I/We will refrain from being flagrantly rude, attempting to intimidate, verbally or physically abuse, heckle, taunt, ridicule, booing, throwing objects and/or uses vulgarity or profane language/gestures.
- I/We will support the coaches and refrain from undermining them.
- I/We will not criticize an opposing team, its players, fans, coaches or team by words or gestures.
- I/We will allow for a 24 hour period prior to confronting any coach, officials, parents or WYF officials over points of disagreement and will give constructive criticism during a private moment, never in front of other parents, players, officials, spectators, etc.
- I/We will accept the decisions of officials on the field as being fair and called to the best ability of the officials. Parents must stay off the field and remain under control in order to set a good example for players and other spectators.
- I/We will not condone the use of any weight reduction or performance enhancing drug or substance of any kind to any player.
- I/We will abide by a coaches, trainers or doctor's decision in all matters of players health and injuries and physical ability to play.
- I/We will follow all rules at practice, home and away fields.

I have read and agree to abide by the Warren Youth Football Parent's and Player's Code of Conduct and understand that my actions may be grounds for my own and my child's suspension or permanent dismissal from participating in the Warren Youth Football organization. Behavior deemed inappropriate may be cause for immediate ejection from the game or stands. Repeat offenses will result in being barred from future games and league sponsored activities. Warren Youth Football shall take appropriate action and its decision shall be final subject to appeal.
