

Provincial High School Track & Field Championships
June 7 & 8, 2019
Gutheridge Field, Moose Jaw, SK

Please note the following:

1. **Scratches:** Please meet at 8:00am with Lyle McKellar at the Awards tent.
2. **Officials' Meeting:** 8:30am at the Awards tent.
3. **Admissions/Registration**
 - Room will be made during registration for vehicles including busses to pull over outside of the main entrance of Riverview Collegiate.
 - Athletes/coaches will register in Riverview Collegiate gymnasium and then exit the school through the west doors which will lead you to Gutheridge Field.
 - Coaches are asked to send the entire athlete delegation through the lines rather than the coaches picking up all of the athlete wristbands.
 - a. **Competitors**
 - i. **Registration**
 1. **Friday 7:30am - 12:00pm**
 - a. Athlete registration will take place in the gymnasium at Riverview Collegiate adjacent to Gutheridge Field.
 - b. Please enter the school through the main doors on Coteau Street where you will be directed to the gymnasium and your District table for registration.
 - c. Identify yourself by name and district and you will receive a wrist band that will allow you to enter the meet.
 - d. The **wristband must be worn the entire meet**. Failure to show your wristband will result in admission being collected.
 2. **Saturday 7:30am - 10:00am**
 - a. Athlete registration will take place beside the admission gate at the west end of Gutheridge Field. (see Friday registration notes c & d)
 - ii. **Late Registration**
 1. **Friday after 12:00pm and Saturday after 10:00am**
 - a. Athletes are to enter through the admission gate at the west end of Gutheridge Field to register and pick up their wristband.
- b. **Coaches**
 - i. **Registration**
 1. You will be required to register in the same manner as the athletes (see times and procedures as noted above).
- c. **General Public**
 - i. Admission gates at the west and east entrances to Gutheridge Field.
 - ii. Adult Admission: \$7.00 per day. Student Admission: \$5.00 per day.
 - iii. A two-day wristband can be purchased on Friday.
4. **Programs**
 - a. Available free of charge (one per family) at the Admissions Gate while supplies last.
5. **Washrooms**
 - a. Porta-potties will be available around the facility for athlete and official use. Washrooms are also located inside of Riverview Collegiate (gymnasium hallway and front lobby only) and in the football locker rooms just east of the high jump area.

6. Coaches Meeting

- a. Saturday, June 8th during the break.
- b. This meeting will take place in Riverview's gymnasium. Please enter school through the west doors and the gymnasium will be the second door on your right as you enter the building. District coaches (2 per district) will be provided with free lunch (Pizza Hut).

7. Marshalling of Athletes

- a. Field events will be marshaled at the event site. ***A reminder that the javelin runway at the Moose Jaw facility is a grass surface.***
- b. Track events will be marshaled at the marshaling tent located at the east end of the facility.

8. Medal and Ribbon Presentations

- a. Field Events
 - i. At the conclusion of each field event, the head official will be requested to bring the top competitors (1st – 8th) to the Awards tent. Then the head official will give the results sheet to the results runners who will take the sheets to the finish line booth. Ribbons will be presented to finishers 4 – 8 while medals will be presented to the top 3.
- b. Track Events
 - i. Within ½ hour of the conclusion of each track event, the top 8 competitors will be called to the Awards tent/Podium for presentations.
- c. **Please remind your athletes they must wear their District uniform for award presentations.**

9. **Sask Milk** will be providing free milk to athletes throughout the competition. Milk distribution will be located at the awards tent as well as there will be volunteers circulating the facility handing milk out.

10. Concessions

- a. Plans are for 3 concession areas to be set up.

11. Reminders

- a. Spectators are allowed on the infield **in viewing areas only**. There are bleachers to sit on at Gutheridge Field but there is also a hill to sit on which is adjacent to the bleachers. Bring lawn chairs and blankets.
- b. We encourage all competitors, coaches and fans to bring plenty of sunscreen, wear a hat and to drink plenty of fluids.
- c. All throwing events are located on the infield of the track.
- d. The Junior Quad shot put will take place in the discus throwing area.
- e. The Junior Quad long will take place in the triple jump pit.
- f. Athletes will have areas sectioned off that they need to stay in while competing. Coaches will not be allowed in these areas, but they can come and speak with their athletes outside of the roped off area.
- g. Tents are allowed around the perimeter of the facility but not in the infield.
- h. Footballs, Frisbees, etc. are not allowed.
- i. Clothing sales from Sport Logo will be available in the garage at the east end of the track.
- j. Results and heat sheets will be posted on event boards on the back of the main bleachers.
- k. Athletes' belonging will be transported by volunteers from the start line to the finish line for the hurdles, 100m, and 200m events.

12. Parking

- a. Parking is at the west end of the facility. Also, Riverview's parking lot may be used on Saturday.
- b. Please see the parking and facility map on the SHSAA website.

13. Medical Facilities

- a. All coaches should equip themselves with the standard first-aid supplies **including tape**, as with any other activity. Ice will be available and an ambulance with EMS staff will be on site as well as a physiotherapist.
- b. The physio will be based out of a room inside Riverview Collegiate. There will be signs posted for directions.
