This year we will not have the same group area with the kitchen but we can still get up to 13 RV spots all together in another group area. Each spot can accommodate one RV with hook up and 2 tents. We just won't have the kitchen so we will need to do the cooking on Big Bertha and our own stoves, both inside and out.

We have a really fun time waterskiing, eating, kayaking, fishing, golfing, hiking, biking and just doing nothing. We have loads of really good cooks so plan to put on the feed bag for a weekend of fun. You can tent or RV, whatever suits you—all are welcome. We are working on getting a boat so, if you have one and are willing to bring it up, please let us know—it is most appreciated. We have one Wave runner (jet ski).

Plan to come up Friday (or Thursday at additional cost). We will have a BBQ Friday and Saturday nights, with the main dinner entree furnished by the Club. Please bring a side dish to share Friday & Saturday. (Salad – A – E Side Dish—F – K Dessert—L – Z) Breakfast will be prepared and served Saturday and Sunday mornings, so please bring something to contribute for both breakfasts, as we all pitch in to make it more affordable for everyone. Coffee & juice will be served before breakfast to help you get the day going. Bring your favorite coffee mug! Lunches will be on your own.

In the evenings, we will have a campfire going.
