



10th Annual Shakopee Lacrosse Tournament

Tournament Rules & Conditions

1. Coaches must turn in roster forms on-line prior to Monday, June 3rd
2. The tournament format will be as follows:
 1. In all divisions, most teams will play 1 pool play game on Friday and the remaining pool play games on Saturday with the potential of extending into Sunday morning. A majority of bracket play will be Sunday for the teams that qualify with some divisions starting as early as Saturday.
 2. Brackets will be updated when pool play completes. Any teams who leave early and are not ready for their bracket game will forfeit their position.
3. Tournament format, game length and number of games are subject to change based on weather.
4. 4. Game Format:
 1. Duration: Two, 20-minute halves. 5-minute halftime. All games are running clock and will start and end on the central horn under all circumstances. Exceptions will be made that involve serious medical attention.
 2. Timeouts: Coaches will get 1 one-minute timeout per game, game clock does not stop during timeout, and can't be used with less than 2 minutes remaining. The 2-minute horn immediately ends all timeouts.
 3. Central Horn: A central horn sound will start game, horn will signal the start of halftime, horn will signal start of second half, a double-horn will signal the two-minute warning in the second half, and a long horn will end game.
 4. Overtime: ▪ Pool Play – no overtime, game ends in tie ▪ Bracket Play – 4-minute sudden death period until the first team scores. If still tied at the end of sudden death; the overtime will go into a Braveheart. Each team will select four players from their team – 3 field players and 1 goalie. No more or less than one field player must be a long pole. Penalties are not served but will result in a change of possession and the penalized player will not be allowed to return to play. The Braveheart will play out until one team scores and is declared the winner.

5. Pool Play Points: 2 Points for Win, 1 Point for a Tie
6. Pool Play Tie Breakers- ▪ Total Pool Points ▪ Head to Head ▪ Goals Allowed ▪ Goal Differential (Max 5 Goals per game) ▪ Goals Scored
5. All protests will be settled on the field, Referee decisions are final.
6. The Tournament Director reserves the right to shorten the length of games in the event of bad weather.
7. Heckling of the referees will not be allowed. The coach of the team whose fans violate this rule will be warned once. If the heckling continues, fans will be asked to leave the premises. Fans not complying within two minutes will cause the forfeiture of the game to the opposing team. Coaches, please discuss this with your fans prior to coming to the tournament to avoid any confusion.
8. Teams must remove all trash from the team area after each game.
9. No outside coolers, except water, or grills allowed. No alcohol allowed.
