## USA/ASA INTERNATIONAL TIE-BREAKER

## Rule 5, Section 11

Once a game has concluded due to time limit OR reached the end of the 7th inning in a tie game, the international tiebreaker takes effect. Starting with the top of the next inning, and each half inning thereafter, the offensive team shall begin it's turn at bat with the player who is scheduled to bat last in that respective half inning being placed on second base (e.g., if the number five batter is the lead-off batter, the number four batter in the batting order will be placed on second base. A substitute may be inserted for the runner if using DP/Flex \& Substitutes are available) There are no outs and each batter begins with a fresh count.

## INCLEMENT WEATHER RULES

- At the discretion of the Tournament Director, the following Inclement Weather rules MAY be invoked at any time for any amount of time during the tournament.
- Game time may be reduced to ONE (1) Hour (Drop Dead or No New Inning - Director Discretion)
- No Infield or Outfield practice balls between innings
- Pitcher will get three warm-up pitches between innings
- We reserve the right to cancel games possibly starting with Pool Play (Blind Draw will then determine Seeding) then Consolation and / or Loser's bracket games.
