- TREASUERS REPORT: Erik Seaborg...current balance is \$39,531. Approx. \$40K-45K from US Ski Snowboard incoming. Secretary report accepted: Joe May, John Manderfield
- RACE COSTS: Cost to put a race on is approx. \$4K (2-day event). CR2 brings in approx. \$18 per start/per race (\$20 for non-Scored). All prices are approximate / for reference information only.
- GRANITE PEAK RACE: Ron Lawrence – 360 racers, resort suffered trying to accommodate the number of racers. Resort had numerous logistics issues from parking, food and total skier capacity. Refunds have been requested by CR1 to Non-Scored racers for lack of 2nd run. Keenan stated the race does not need to be 2 runs. 2 (two) one run races were provided to the non-scored racers. Joe May inquired to refund the entire non-scored race. Rules were followed to deliver the races, product was delivered. Partial refund (\$9 for every start) recommended for non-scored racers by John Manderfield / Board passes motion to issue partial refund
