

PTHC Minutes 2/27/24

- Budget- the board reviewed the Treasurer report from last month to present.
- Financial Updates- several club members across all teams need to review their SportsEngine accounts to ensure that all credit card information is up to date and that assessments have been paid on time. The treasurer will be reaching out to the club members this week to help facilitate up-to-date payments on several accounts that are past due.
- Book Checks- it was noted that the managers did a nice job being organized for book checks. Additionally, since PTHC currently has a very unique goal situation this year, the club is looking into revising and/or updating the policy.
- Scholarships- information for all of the scholarships available for Seniors will be sent out this week by the President.
- Playoff Update- things are underway for Middle School, JV and Varsity Playoffs. PIHL will require the money be collected and sent in. The process for this will be sent out to all business managers.
- Banquet- the 2024 Banquet is being held on Mon, April 29th @ The Hilton Garden Inn at Southpointe from 6-9pm. Information on registering will be coming within the next few weeks.

- James DeAngelo Foundation Banner Update- the foundation is working with PTHC on getting a banner put up at Printscape. The arena is creating a space for it where it will be hung from year to year. The banner will be 30 x 60 and the cost is 100% covered by the JDA foundation.

- 2024/2025 Sponsors- potential new sponsors for the upcoming season include: Peters Barbershop, LoveLee Salon (they did the Varsity hair-dye this season for playoffs.) Getting commitments for sponsors early in the season is a must for offsetting assessment costs.

- Voting/Board Positions- there are 3 available openings for the PTHC board for the upcoming year: Director of Operations, Registrar and Secretary. More information regarding these positions will be forthcoming and voting will take place at the annual banquet.

- Tenband Usage- prior to playoffs, there is an average of 311 viewers per Varsity game. Continuing the contract with Tenband was discussed and will be re-evaluated for next season once playoff viewings are calculated.

- Spiritwear- to date, the club has made \$1,015.50 as a profit from sales. In prior years, the club's profits were close to triple. Next year, the club will be looking at ways to either increase sales, or look into other options for Spiritwear.

- JR Indian Pictures- JR. Indians make-up date will be Sunday, March 25th from 3:30-4:00pm. An email will be sent out gauging interest and availability to the families that have reached out regarding make-ups.
