



## Skokie Amateur Hockey Association Ice Rink and Mitigation Protocols

The following details the Skokie Amateur Hockey Association's Ice Rink protocols. Please do take the time to carefully read this email.

### **Ice Rink Protocols:**

The Skokie Amateur Hockey Association utilizes 3 hockey rinks. Below are the safety protocols for each rink used.

#### **Skokie Skatium:**

1. Masks are mandatory in the building and while on the ice. Skaters must come to the rink dressed or dress in the parking lot by the car. Skates may be put on by the bench area. The Skatium will no longer allow skaters to dress on the benches in front of the rink.
2. Locker rooms are not available for skaters to use at the Skatium at this time. Goalies may use locker room 1 to get dressed.
3. One parent may enter the rink while teams are practicing. Please maintain social distancing, and please remember that masks are mandatory.

#### **Mount Prospect Ice Arena:**

1. Mount Prospect Ice Arena has two separate entrances, one for each rink. Only skaters may enter the rink. Masks are mandatory and, while in the locker room, skaters must maintain social distance. Masks must be worn on the ice.
2. Parents may remain in the parking lot or visit the restaurant on the second floor. Masks are mandatory when entering the restaurant.

#### **Jet Ice Arena:**

1. Masks are mandatory while in the locker rooms and on the ice.
2. Parents are not permitted in the building.

#### **On/Off Ice Mitigation Strategies:**

The following strategies will be utilized while our skaters engage in practices.

1. While on the ice, the use of a mask is mandatory. All players and coaches must have a mask on. There is no exception to this mandate.
2. Coaches will run practice drills that minimize close contact for extended periods of time.
3. When engaging in off ice training, skaters must maintain the use of a mask.
4. Social distancing will be enforced when off ice training.
