II. Approval of Minutes

- The minutes of the October meeting were distributed via email prior to the meeting.

III. Treasurer's Report

- Kirby Brownfield asked if that balance was typical for this period in the season and Beth thought that balance was a bit higher than normal, even with referee fees going up.

VIII. New Business

IX. Tournament Discussion

- CAHA has decided to take back the end of the year tournament and selected a date many teams could not attend.
- We have secured the previously scheduled date for the tournament of 2/6-2/8
- There will potentially be one round robin on Thursday in Irmo
- The fee increase is considerable and Kirby discussed us potentially supporting the teams with a portion of the \$2500.00 they have to pay
- Palmetto tournament will be run the same and will be run by SCSHA still
- There were several questions regarding how CAHA came up with the fee, one of them was wondering if their pricing was using NC prices instead of SC prices.
- The tournament fees last year were \$13,500 for ALL teams.
- We still do not have a location for the Palmetto tournament. It was previously booked in Greenville, however they can no longer host it....unless we schedule games at 1:00am.
- Kirby reached out to the new Florence Civic Center and they were excited about the opportunity to host but were unable to the weekend of 2/6-2/8, however they are willing to host the first weekend of March and the fee would be \$440 an hour but were confident they could get some sponsorships.
- Do we want to host an All Star Night and skills competition?
- Thoughts on March Palmetto tourn: some thought it would be fun, others worried about the break in practices and time on the ice. Kirby asked for everyone to send him thoughts on this.
